BROOKLYN, Nov. 9 (AP)—Branch Rickey, busy Brooklyn president, clinched three days of activity Tuesday by re-signing Burt Shotton as Dodger manager, selling another player to a rival National league club, and laying the groundwork for a "big" trade that may bring the league champions a top-flight pitcher.

In announcing the re-signing of Shotton, Rickey simply said: "Burt Shotton is my manager for 1950."

Rickey did not disclose the terms of the length of Shotton's contract, which incidentally has not yet been signed. However, it was learned that Shotton was hired for one year at the same salary he received for being the Dodger manager in 1949.

We're happy to have Burt back," Rickey told newsmen at the weekly press conference. "He did a magnificent job last year."

Shotton, who never flew in from his Barrow, Fla., winter home for the season, was expected to be in town by his four-week vacation. Shotton was a far different person from the one who was dismissed from the job last year.

Following the series there was considerable speculation that Burt would return.

It was learned that Shotton predicted another Dodger win in 1950 and added: "I think this same club can win the world series. Has Big to Miss. "How can you go into the draft," explained Rickey. "This is the first time in four years that I am in position to bid for a draft player. I've got a sleeper in mind. I don't recall a player because I haven't recalled anybody else since this time in the draft. The Brooklyn club has the 16th and last pick you know."

Rickey and Shotton both agreed that the club was all set as it was except for the need of one good pitcher.

"We have been negotiating for a good reliable veteran pitcher," Rickey said. "The man I have in mind can start games and relieve if necessary. We have enough good kid pitchers. What we need is a reliable veteran pitcher."

Although Rickey did not say, it was learned that Ken Patterson, beryle ball pitcher, was expected to be in the game for the Dodger team after.

"The birds, most of them," he said, "would rather stand outside and drown during a storm than take shelter. That cuts into the profits—especially after you've nursed a flock from egg to market. But they will do it every time."

Dr. Knox told about growers who found six prize birds smothered in a barn which had been left in a turkey yard. Somehow, they managed to get under and into the barrel. Once inside, the turks didn't know how to get out.

### 41,000,000 Turkeys Prepared For Holiday Tables This Year

By HARMAN W. NICHOLS  
DELTAVILLE, Md., Nov. 9 (AP)—

H. L. Schroder, senior poultryman of the department of agriculture, who also is known as the world champion turkey carver, said today setting a new record for one Thanksgiving.

"He's got a broader wing this year," Meaning the 1949 turkey has a wider breast and fatter legs and therefore is more for a shrader.

He said the largest turkey he has ever carved is a 27-pounder. He says the birds are smaller and the flavor finer than any since the Pilgrims caught their birds on the wing.

Some 41,000,000 gobblers are ready for the holiday market—one of the largest crops in history. And thanks to experiments performed here and at agricultural stations throughout the country, the output is one of the best.

Furthermore, this year's holiday bird grew up faster than any other on record.

Back in great-granddad's day, it took some nine months to raise a poult big enough for the carving knife. Today, due to cross-breeding, time elapsed is seven months. Some day, according to the department of agriculture, this time will be cut to five and a half months.

That, of course, will save the housewife money. Turkeys will be cheaper because they are fatter and eat less while they are growing up—and turkey food is expensive.
