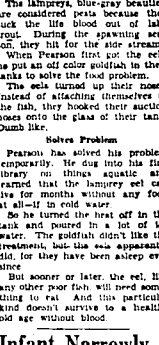

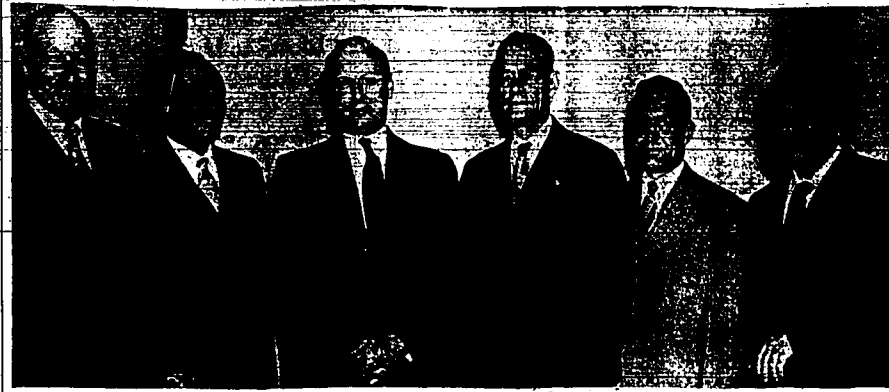

Farm Workers' Life 'Pitiful'

CHICAGO, Nov. 11—(AP)—The life of farm workers in California is "pitiful," says a report by the state commission on farm workers in southern California. A labor official said the report, prepared by the state labor union, "reveals that farm workers have never seen in a state in the south."

The report, which will see 100,000 of the state's farm workers, says that the life of farm workers is "pitiful" and that the state should provide for them. The report also says that the state should provide for farm workers in several ways, including the creation of a grand jury in Hanford to begin an investigation into the conditions of farm workers.

Civil Service Job Opening Tests Are Set

Civil service examinations for geologist, highway engineer trainee, highway engineer and highway bridge engineer were announced Thursday by Mr. E. Schroeder, chief service administrator.

Most of the geologist positions are with the geological survey and the bureau of reclamation in the department of the interior; bureau of plant industry and soil conservation in the department of agriculture, and corps of engineers in the department of the army. The highway engineering positions are mainly with the bureau of public roads or the department of commerce.

The geologist examinations cover mineralogy and petrology, geomorphology and glaciology, geology of metallic and non-metallic minerals, geology, stratigraphy, stratigraphy, paleontology, ground water geology, geology of fuels, general geology and engineering geology. Salaries are \$2,100 and \$2,225. Applicants, applicants must pass a written test and have appropriate college study or a certificate of high school graduation. The applicant must have one year of professional experience or appropriate graduate work in geology. Applications will be accepted from students who expect to complete the required course by July 1, 1939.

Applicants for the highway engineer trainee positions must pass a written test and have college study in civil engineering. Salaries run from \$2,220 to \$3,100 a year. For the \$2,220 position, appropriate professional experience may be substituted for college study.

Applicants for the highway engineer and highway bridge engineer positions must pass a written test and have one year of professional highway engineer or bridge engineer experience or completed requirements for a master's degree in engineering. The positions pay \$2,225 a year. Applications will be accepted from students who expect to complete the required course by July 1, 1939.

Age limit is 36 years for all positions up to the \$3,100 jobs. The highway engineer positions have an age limit of 32 years. Age limit may be waived for veterans. Further information and application forms may be obtained from Robert P. the Twin Falls position. Applications from civil service regional offices of the U. S. civil service commission in Washington, D. C. Applications for the geologist examinations must be received in Washington, D. C. not later than Nov. 11, 1938, and applications for the highway engineering positions not later than Nov. 8, 1938.
