The Chamber of Commerce and city council have dubbed the nation's longest, smog-tinged wasteland and fired a salvo of statements. Their target is a postcard smog campaign which has been taking members of commerce throughout the nation that Los Angeles is crime-infested and a good place to stay away from.

Wart Treadwell, mailed from San Diego about Nov. 13, the printed-and-addressed cards claim that "law and order no longer exist in Los Angeles, that innocent citizens and helpless tourists are held up, assaulted, robbed and thrown into filthy, overcrowded jails." The cards recommend that tourists keep away from Los Angeles.

REGIONALIZING SCHOOLS

The 11 western states have followed the lead of the south and agreed to pool educational facilities regionally to raise the level of training in specialized fields like medicine, law and engineering.

A far higher caliber of training is expected to result from the regional plans. Under this set-up each state will seek to make itself the educational specialist in a limited number of fields.

Each state will send its students beyond its borders for training in specialties not taught at home. In turn it will accept students from other states who wish to study its own specialties.

This plan not only promises to assure high educational standards; it also will eliminate much wasteful duplication of facilities.

Although the less wealthy regions are showing a tendency to co-operative efforts like this educational plan, the richer sections of the country are not aware of the advantages in such arrangements.

There is serious talk about setting up a central depository for material not in too heavy demand in the western area, to be made jointly the requirements of the New York public library and those at Harvard, Yale, Columbia and perhaps others.

Further, the western states already have a number of similar schemes for correctional institutions and state hospitals.

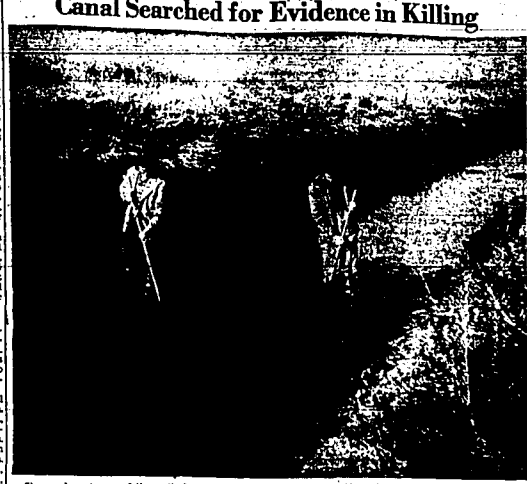

Reds Pushing 'Word' Battle Asking Peace

By WILLIAM L. BYAN
American from that quarter
Russia pursued today a campaign of words aimed at convincing the western world that it is possible for capitalists and communists to live together in peace. The press is re-echoing it widely.

The official Moscow press has set a salvo based upon this so-called cooperation in possibility, but the United States blocks the way to accord on problems of atomic energy.

"Played by Paper
Diplomats," says the New York Herald Tribune, "with all the authority of the Kremlin, gave front page prominence to their statements of Prime Minister Stalin and to those of Lenin, too, dealing with the possibility of Marxist-capitalist cooperation."

For months Russia has been engaged in a campaign which some diplomats regard as a peace offensive, aimed at portraying the Soviet Union as the sole champion of world peace. It also could be looked upon as an attempt to divert attention from the little nations set to end the cold war by its implicit threat to their security.

Such statements also could be regarded as attempts to foster more trade within Britain and United States demanding that Russia should be given preference for peace.

The campaign was renewed in the United Nations a few days when Soviet Foreign Minister Andrei V. Vishinsky declared: "It is possible to find a common ground for cooperation." This was a flouting remark in a speech otherwise devoted to flaying the proposal for the division of Russia's wealth in a big power peace pact.
