"Based upon this experience it is my feeling that encouragement and development of this idea can be made into a long way toward reducing our traffic violations and the untimely accidents resulting therefrom."

Other benefits

"This citizen cooperation program will have the effect of making it more difficult for the average citizen more thoroughly aware of the methods and purposes of the new traffic laws and will tend to make them realize that the strictness of regulations is designed for their benefit and protection rather than to merely a trap for the unwary."

"It is not to be doubted that will often participate in a traffic violation will result but only in the punishment of the more penalizing provisions of the law. The interest in and observance of the principles of safe driving is the chief aim of this program."

West's Timber Owners Have Little Trouble

WASHINGTON, Nov. 20.—Despite the fact that there are some time limits on conservation practices in the western timber owners get along with the forest service.

Washington led in number of deaths with 123, including two men killed by a single ricocheting bullet as they stood back to back. Michigan and Minnesota followed with 14 each.

New York states led for all types of deaths with 29, including 13 from shooting. Minnesota was second with 28 and Michigan third with 24. Montana, however, reported only 22 deaths, a drop from last year despite a 10 per cent increase in hunting licenses.

The tragedy was heightened in today's news because the killer and the victims were close relatives or friends in Oklahoma, a father who shot a young boy in Colorado, a son killed his father, mistaking him for a bear. In Illinois, a woman shot at a president and killed her husband.

Washington state game department officials began an intensive study of the state's hunting deaths in an effort to learn how to stop them. A Georgia hunter was clawed to death by a wounded bear. Another hunter was killed while aiming at an electrified fence. A Utah hunter shot himself while aiming at a moose. In Texas, a hunter went into a pond to save his dog which began to bawled under trying to retrieve a pheasant.

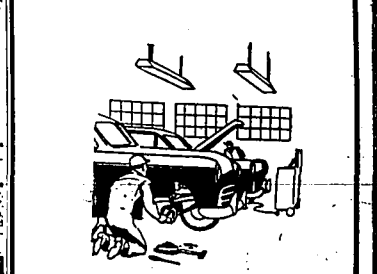

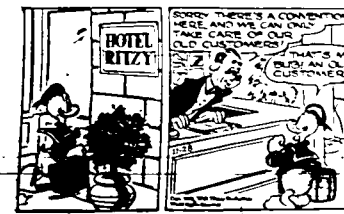

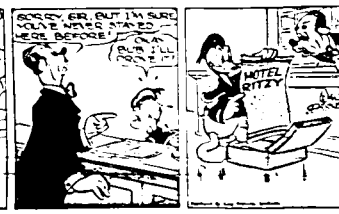
