FBI Joins in Check of Hall Blast Attempt

DETROIT, Dec. 21 (AP)—The FBI moved in today to have a look at the Detroit plant of the United Auto Workers union. 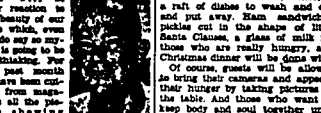

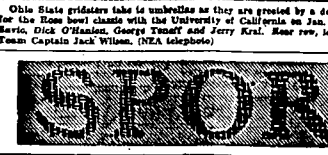
