GERMANS CONTINUE MORE FRENCH HOSTAGES

RUSSIANS STRIKE AT FINNS' LINES

 German authorities in Paris announced the execution of more French hostages today even as France today reported the shooting of a reprisal for 20 persons held under death sentence at Bizkaia where a newspaper aided British commandos in their spectacular raid on that Nazi-occupied beach March 28.

The Paris announcement said the victims, described as Communists, Jews and accomplices, were not in reprisal for alleged assassination attempts against German soldiers on April 8 and 9.

Advices reaching Bern, Switzerland, said that the St. Nazaire headquarters, and some prominent residents, had been sentenced to be shot by the executioners were put off as a result of Vichy's intervention.

Smothering fires of revolt against the Nazi conquerors was reflected here as German authorities in Paris clamped down on a curfew and ordered all public places closed in the occupied capital since 5 a. m. Friday.

Urges Cleanup

All voluntary

The war bond and stamp pledges, canvassed persons with an income to regular purchases, are entirely voluntary. The Twin Falls chairman, Claude DeWetter, said that the financial emergency can suspend his purchases temporarily by contacting either the area warden, the chairman or Mr. Toftmire.

Leaders in the drive emphasized that the pledges do not constitute a duplication of an additional promise in cases where residents are already purchasing bonds under the payroll allotment plan. In such cases, it was explained, the pledge card is simply a means of tabulating for the treasury.
