Yank Troops Seize North Sicilian Port

ALLIED HEADQUARTERS, North Africa, July 26 (AP)—Allied troops drove the axis deeper into its last foothold of northeastern Sicily today as the Americans captured the port of Termini Imerese, 20 miles southeast of Palermo, and boosted their number of prisoners to more than 70,000.

As the final lunges to crush the enemy of Sicily approached, the German and Italian forces fell back to the north coast. The momentum-belted coastline already had been reduced to little more than 135 miles.

Steering eastward to help jam the enemy back into the sea, the American Seventh Army took 1,000 new prisoners, including six Italian generals and an admiral.

As the British and American combined forces advanced into the central Sicily, they captured the strategic town of Enna in a threat to cut squarely through the middle of the axis line.

German Believed—Ston German forces, still resisting the British Eighth Army before Catania on the east, were reported to have fled to the interior.

The Nazi 24th motorized division was reported in the Messina area above Catania, bringing the total of enemy troops in the Mt. Etna area to about 200,000.

Waiting for the American and Canadian pushes to catch up, the Axis has reduced its activity to patrolling.

SURRENDER ONLY TERMS OF PEACE FOR ITALY-HULL

WASHINGTON, July 26 (AP)—Secretary of State Cordell Hull said today that the Casablanca terms of unconditional surrender for axis enemies of the United Nations still apply to Italy.

Questioned at his press conference about this government attitude toward the "reignition" of Benito Mussolini, Hull said he did not anticipate any change in the announced policy that axis enemies would be dealt with only on the basis of unconditional surrender.

No Policy Change—There has been no information of any impending change in policy either from the government spokesman or from the war department, Hull said. Despite Badoglio's assertion that he would be satisfied to accept the terms of unconditional surrender, Hull said that the Italian people are still being urged to resist invasion were they to be designated as traitors and street riding as well as an effort to restore national dignity and sense of country to the Italian people.

If the Italian people fail to rally to the cry to defend the homeland against invading armies in Sicily, Hull said, the United States would ask the allies for terms.

Historic Event—White officials were cautious in speaking of the historic event. If Italy, there could be no doubt that the world was going through one of the significant moments in its history in the breakup of the Berlin-Rome alliance.

The demoralization of an already badly shaken nation appeared to be quickly completed and the remaining date for Italy's unhappy 21-year experiment in fascism seemed just ahead.

The Casablanca decision to wage war on the German empire was conditionally to be applied to Italy and the future rules of Italy will be determined only by the Italian people who have an opportunity to be heard on the subject.

POGAATELO, July 26 (AP)—Three officers were killed and six men injured in parachuting from a four-engine bomber from the Poggiatele airbase that crashed Saturday afternoon in rugged country north of Minidoka, Liek Ben F. Rogers, base public relations officer, said.

PARADE, July 26—Sheriff Fred Abrams accompanied army air force troops on a parade through the town of Poggiatele, July 26 (AP)—A federal grand jury investigating record unauthorized strikes in the soft coal fields of southwestern Kentucky today indicted 30 persons.

The indictments charged defendants specifically with "combining, conspiring and conspiring together to interfere by strike and other interruptions with the operation" of mines operated by the government.

LONDON, July 26 — Martial law was proclaimed throughout harassed Italy today in swift succession to a government shakeup which eliminated Benito Mussolini and his fascist cabinet and installed the conservative Marshal Pietro Badoglio as premier.

King Vittorio Emanuele made the change in the war leadership, the first major break on the axis front and a possible prelude to an Italian bid for peace.

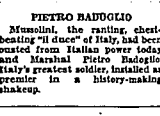
There was no axis announcement of what had become of Mussolini but unconfirmed reports from Stockholm said he had been arrested while trying to flee to Germany.
