Bombs Wiping out Germany's

Claims to Industrial Power

ALJED HEADQUARTERS, North Africa, Sept. 17 (UP)—The allied fifth army has crushed three more German counterattacks, rolled the enemy back 11 miles from the Salerno beaches, and made patrol contact with the British eighth army racing up from the south to join the drive on Naples, Rome, and northern Ltaly.

Fighting on the Salerno front south of Naples continued heavy but the offensive started yesterday by Lieut. Gen. Mark W. Clark's fifth army surged slowly forward, inflicting heavy casualties on the Germans, capturing three tanks, taking prisoners and knocking out considerable nazi armor to weaken enemy counter thrusts.




