## Cherbourg Fall Near as Yanks Blast Way Into City's Suburbs

**SUPREME HEADQUARTERS ALLIED EXPEDITIONARY FORCE, June 21 (AP)—**The fall of Cherbourg opened a matter of hours tonight as U. S. troops stormed two key inner fortresses guarding the great port—one of them less than a mile from the commercial docks—and fought house-to-house in the suburbs.

A radio broadcast from Normandy said "our ground forces are moving into Cherbourg," but there was no confirmation here.

Another force rolling the trapped German back on the left flank seized Acqueville, at the base of Cape De La Hague, the land finger jutting northwest of Cherbourg, and possibly offering a chance of escape by sea.

Troops on the right flank advanced beyond Valognes, and in press headquarters declared "good progress" was made toward the "pink harbor."

Supported by powerful artillery and air bombardment, veteran American troops overtook Fort De La Hague, within a mile of Cherbourg docks, and Fort Gertrude, further inland, in front of the military harbor area, blasted by most of the day.

The Germans staged a last ditch defense in these strongpoints, and fighting was reported in the built-up suburban section of France's greatest port.

On the flank to the north, only 11 miles from the tip of the Cape De La Hague, the American advance captured "Festung" (Fortress) two miles south of Acqueville.

Eighty tank tanks have been destroyed, the allied liberation armies to date, supreme headquarters said.

Heavy fighting was reported in the Tilly-sur-Seulles area near the center of the front, and an American spearhead to the west had pushed within two miles of the communications hub of Normandy.

Port de la Hague, a major key to control of the beachhead, which will play a role in the final assault on the city, stands atop a 450-foot hill.

Smoke hung over the city as the trapped German defenders carried out hurried demolitions in the strategic area now in the hands of the attacking American troops centered out of the hills surrounding their position.

German defenses stiffened and there are indications that the nation's command has ordered a last ditch defense.

## HULL HITS BACK AT YANKS' WAR GUILT TALK

**WASHINGTON, June 21 (AP)—**After a month's silence, the Pearl Harbor was following the "single policy of self defense," Secretary Hull declared in a sharp rebuttal to what he termed an "erroneous statement by the Japanese production minister—an assertion that brought a personal apology to the house of commons today from its author.

The British minister, Capt. Oliver Lyttelton, told the house he had no intention of saying in a speech yesterday that American blockade aid to Britain had forced Japan into attacking the United States.

Asserting any such statement was "a deliberate attempt to mislead," he said that it was not his intention of saying that the blockade was a "travesty of history."

Lyttelton earlier released his own version of the interpretation that contained no reference to the question asserted by his own American press officer.

## Snowdown Battle Looms as Yanks Hit at Enemy's Sea Power in Full Force

**U.S. FLEET HEADQUARTERS, Pearl Harbor, June 21 (AP)—**American carrier planes attacked a strong Japanese fleet including aircraft carriers and battleships midway between Luzon and Saipan before dusk Monday in the first day of an action which Ad. Chester W. Nimitz hopes may develop into a decisive naval battle, the Pacific fleet commander's communique announced today.

The communique said: "Enemy losses and our own losses have not yet been assessed."

With tonightfall the American aerial attack on the enemy ships presumably had to be broken off.

Nimitz promised: "Additional details will be made known as soon as they become available."

The communique mentioned that there were enemy losses to be assessed could mean that our carrier bomber scored hits on the powerful Japanese fleet.

Four carrier bombers and fighters immediately were ordered to attack.

A CITY OF 30,000. Philip Kingston, new secretary of the Chamber of Commerce, visited the city of Twin Falls the other night when he told the Jaycees that this city can be built into a community of 30,000 inhabitants within 10 years after the war.

Optimistic as this prediction may sound, we are inclined to agree with Mr. Kingston, and there are many indications to bear out this possibility.

Despite the fact that Twin Falls has had no war production plants of any kind to swell its population and many of its inhabitants have gone elsewhere to take employment, such growth in the city's population has actually increased, to the point that houses and apartments are at a premium.

Coupled with this condition are the many airplane plants in the area, and the industries have located in Twin Falls and other plans to come here in the near future. An entire industrial area has been set aside by the Chamber of Commerce for just that purpose.

With plans taking shape for one of the finest airports in the state and a number of airlines competing for the opportunity to fly in Twin Falls, there is every indication that this is to become an important point in the future development of aviation.
