# Allies Rip Nazi Defense for New Gains in France

ALLIED SUPREME HEADQUARTERS, London, July 4 (UP)—American forces, advancing up to two and a half miles in the first 24 hours of their new offensive, have seized high ground overlooking the German communications center of La Haye-Du Puits in western Normandy, it was announced today. The capture of point 131, only two and a half miles northeast of La Haye, gave Lieut. Gen. Omar N. Bradley's first army commanding artillery positions from which to support an attack on the enemy stronghold itself.
