# Patton Within 22 Miles Of Paris; Nazis Reported Preparing to Yield City

SUPREME HEADQUARTERS, AEF., Aug. 17 (UP) — Rough-riding American tanks and infantrymen were reported storning into the outer suburbs of Paris, only 22 miles from the city gates, today and front dispatches hinted that the German army may be abandoning the old French capital without a fight.

The German high command broadcast a special amounteement of heavy fighting around the suburban town of \$t. Armoult, on the Chartes-Paris highway, indicating that Lieut-Gen, George S. Patton's armored columns had plunged on 21 miles past Chartres and 10 miles post their new Aunty river bridghead within the past few hours.

(The clandestine radio station Atlantic said the Americans were in the outskirts of Versuilles, 13 miles from Paris proper.)
