## HAPS END MAMLA RULE W ORYY OF BLOOO AND FRE

 No Holds Will Be Barred In Fight to the Death; Rules of War Scrapped
## LONDON, Feb. 14 (UP)-European dispatches said today that Germany has proclaimed

 her intention of scrapping the rules of war for a "no-holds-barred" fight to the death, as a result of the big three's Crimean declaration. The new policy is said to have been set forth yesterday by Paul Schmidt, official spokesman for the German foreign office, in an angry outburst at the Wilhelmstrasse over the joint statement of President Roosevelt, Prime Minis-ter Churchill and Premier Stalin. Stockholm sources speculated that Schmidt's statement might foreshadow German use of poison gas. The death sentence outlined for Germany in the Crimean declaration frees the reich of "all moral obligations" to abide by the rules of war, the nazi-controlled Scandinavian telegraph bureau quoted Schmidt as saying at a press conference. "The Germans henceforth will conduct the war with all suitable means, no matter how grim their effect," Schmidt said. The STB dispateh, published in Stockholm newspapers, said mention of the Crimean declaration caused "by far the worst explosion" foreign correspondents ever have witnessed at a Wilhelmstrasse press conference.
