GUAM, Feb. 16 (AP) -Toyko was raided by more than 1,500 American carrier planes today in an unprecedented attack which Japanes headquarters said lasted for more than nine hours while the greatest naval fleet ever assembled hunted for a fight within 300 miles of Japan's shores. Protecting Vice Adm. Marc A. Mitscher's carrier forces, battleships, cruisers and destroyers of Adm. Raymond A. Spruance's fifth fleet spread out in a 200 mile column in Japanese waters, daring the enemy fleet to come out.
Seven hundred miles to the south another task force, which Tokyo said was comprised of more than 30 warships, including battleships and carriers, shelled Iwo Jima in coordination with land-based bombers which have been attacking the island outpost daily for two months.
