7 Yes-the average oil well, drilled by Union Oil in California, costs $\$ 65,88 s$. If you divide that lexpense between two men, it would cost them $\$ 32,944$ apiece. But if you di-
vide it among 31,375 people, as we do, the average cost to each person is only $\$ 2.10$.


- In the enrly 1890's, for example, you could drill an oil well in the California fields for about $\$ 2500$. Today, because we go so much deeper and need such expensive equipment, it costs almast 26 times as much. Furthermore, the chances of getting oil in an exploratory well are only 1 in 12
