## 4 ARMIES RIP NAZI RHINE LINE <br> Russians Smash to 45 Mile Advances In West Hungary 

 in a historic crossing yesterday, invaded the flaming Ruhr and north German plain on a end-the-war offensive.In the most massive operation since D-day, the British second army and elements of the Canadian first army gouged out a 15-mile wide bridgehead stretching from west of Rees to Wesel, northwestern gateway to the vital Ruhr's huge munitions cities.
The U. S. ninth army plunged four miles east into the Ruhr itself with a crossing two to four miles south of Wesel and ground out a solid 12 -mile wide bridgehead, and was four
