Yank Pilots Report Eoe Abandoning All Northwest Germany

PARIS, April 4 (AP)—American third army troops burst through the German center little more than 100 miles from Berlin today and air pilots reported the Nazis may be abandoning northwest Germany and falling back for a death stand on the Elbe river, 43 miles from Berlin.

The forces of Lieut. Gen. George S. Patton are only 160 miles from Russian front lines, as the scissor-squeeze on German tightens.

British troops reached the Elbe river 48 miles from the North Sea today in a drive to trap 90,000 Germans in Holland, and ninth army tanks pulled up to the Weser, next to the last important stream on the high road to Berlin.

Lieut. Gen. William Simpson's fifth armored division reached the Weser at Bad Oeynhausen, 135 miles from Berlin, moved eight miles down the shore of Nagasaki bay, former Japanese fleet anchorage, to the town of Misaki.

Refugee centers have been established and Japanese civilians are being moved to the mainland. Flight varies when they receive food and treatment.

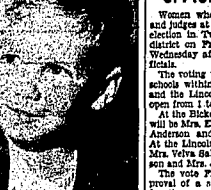

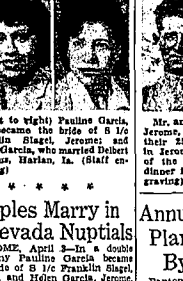
