# Allies Advance on Solid Front of 14 Miles in Germany 

 Sheds Neutrality PactBecause Nips Aid Nazis;
Cabinet in Tokyo Falls

LONDON, April 5 (AP) -Russia today denounced its neutrality pact with Japan, accusing Tokyo of helping Germany to war against Russia.
The Moscow radio announced that Foreign Commissar Vyacheslav Molotov had informed the Japanese ambassedor that continuance of the compact was impossible since Japan was fighting against Russia's allies, the United States and Great Britain.
"In such a situation the pact of neutrality between Japan and the USSR has lost its meaning," Molotov said. The note was handed the Japanese amibassador at 3 p. m. today in the midst of a new Japanese cabinet crisis.
The Soviet note emphasized that the pact of neutrality between the Soviet Union and Japan was concluded before the attack by Germany on the USSR, and before the outbreals of war between Japan on one hand and Great Britain and the United States on the other.
