Troops Race for Trieste as Peace Settles on Italy

ROME, May 3 (UP)—New Zealand troops raced along the Adriatic coast to occupy the port of Trieste today while peace settled over the rest of the Italian front. First official reports did not clarify the position at Trieste, which the Yugoslav army of Marshal Tito claimed to have occupied yesterday.

In the rest of Italy, the noise of battle had died away for the first time since the Salerno invasion in September, 1943. Hundreds of thousands of allied troops and nearly a million enemy troops stood by while the physical details of completing the German surrender were worked out.

The allied armies which won the great victory took strong hints from their commanders they would be rotated to the east for the final fight against Japan.

An aerial conference from allied force headquarters said fighting had ceased in north Italy west of the Isonzo river with the unconditional surrender of German army group "G." Only the details of assembling and disarming remnants of the German force remained.

The communists said the 15th army group took more than 230,000 prisoners before fighting ended. Trieste was captured yesterday.

General Sir Bernard Freyberg, commander of the New Zealanders, accepted the surrender of the German garrison at 4:30 p. m.

In Rome, Italy, the news of the surrender was dampened by the developments at Trieste. Ivanhoe Boroni pointed out in his message of thanks to Marshal Sir Bernard Freyberg that "most of the Italian people are still waiting for the German surrender to be official."

The Popolo, Christian democratic paper, and Libera Stampa, organ of the center-right, both carried headlines calling for an Italian "Primo Maggio" to mark the anniversary of the surrender of Trieste.

15,777 YANKS KILLED WASHINGTON, May 3 (UP)—The conquest of Italy cost the United States more than 150,000 combat casualties, Secretary of War Henry H. Stimson disclosed today.

Stimson said his press conference that the U. S. fifth army had suffered 150,000 casualties from the start of the Italian campaign, April 22.

By April 28, the Germans in Italy had been sent into the headlong rout which culminated in their unconditional surrender yesterday.

Of the fifth losses, 15,777 were listed as killed, 72,746 wounded, 10,338 missing.

HIMMLER SLAIN IS NEWEST REPORT

12TH ARMY GROUP HQ, May 3 (UP)—Lieut.-Gen. Kurt Dittmar, former German high command commander, said today that he believed a report that Heinrich Himmler may have been assassinated for the slayings he handled peace negotiations.

REDS SAY SUICIDE LONDON, May 3 (UP)—Adolf Hitler, who vowed to rape the world, committed suicide in the ruins of Berlin with Propaganda Minister Paul Joseph Goebbels and the chief of the German general staff, Gen. Wilhelm Doenicke, the Communists said today.

The Russians declared their intention to execute Hitler, Goebbels and Doenicke, captured as Berlin fell. Whether Hitler was a suicide or whether he was the victim of a Russian honor killing, he was suggested by General Eisenhower, who said that the future would show whether he met death in a manner which would justify any dishonor and attempt to build a Wehrmacht legend about him.

VETERANS' BONUS CAMPAIGN BEGINS WASHINGTON, May 3 (UP)—A veterans bonus drive, with an estimated \$10,000,000,000 price tag attached, is in full swing as Capitol Hill.

It got off to a flying start under the guidance of Rep. Rankin, D-Mo., chairman of the House Veterans' Affairs committee and one of the framers of the bill of rights.

It calls for payment of \$20 a week for a year to any member of the armed forces who served in the war more since Sept. 16, 1914, as a non-dishonorably discharged.

On the basis of \$100 each for those more than 10,000,000 men and women eligible, the total would be in the neighborhood of \$1 billion.

The adjusted compensation would be in addition to existing pay and allowances, and information is being sent to \$100,000, depending on the length and place of service.

MOSCOW HEARS RUMOR of Immediate Nazi Yielding; British Occupy Hamburg

LONDON, May 3 (UP)—A BBC front reporter, broadcasting over the army radio, said today that a general surrender of the German troops facing Lieut. Gen. Sir Miles C. Dempsey's (British second) army may come at any moment.

LONDON, May 3 (AP)—A Reuters dispatch from Moscow said today that rumors of Germany's immediate unconditional surrender were circulating in the Russian capital. These cannot be strictly confirmed, the dispatch said.

PARIS, May 3 (UP)—Hamburg surrendered to the British second army today. The great port had been declared an open city a few hours earlier by its radio. It was second in size to Norway.

That indicated the Czechoslovak capital would not be defended. Hamburg, Europe's largest port and Germany's second city of 1,682,220, had been outflanked and besieged for several weeks. It was largely in ruins because bombers had made it a frequent target.

"Hamburg is in an open city in German hands," proclaimed "British occupation troops are now entering the city."

The northern German holdings were split into several untenable pockets and the southern section was shrunk by the surrender in Italy of nearly 1,000,000 German combat and service troops. The Alpine "redoubt" was virtually wiped out under terms of the surrender.

WORKER HURT IN CHEMICAL BLAST WENDELL, May 3 (Jack Dooden, 35, was in critical condition at St. Valentine's hospital here this afternoon suffering a severe skull fracture as a result of an explosion in the main building of the W. W. Driggs Supply company, where he was employed.

HITLER HOUSE OF CARDS CRUMBLES

LONDON, May 3 (UP)—Unconditional surrender of all German forces in Holland, Denmark, Norway and Czechoslovakia was reported under negotiation today, or in some cases perhaps already.

# THE AMERICAN HOUSE

Spring brought open roads, and travelers. A good many of these were drummers who either drove their own horses from place to place or hired transportation from the nearest stables along their route.
