The Germans, who once held virtually all of Europe in their power, today are reduced to a slipping clutch on an estimated 175,000 square miles of territory. Exact delineation square miles of territory. Exact delineation of the German holdings was impossible due to the shifting lines of battle in Czechoslo-vakia, Austria and Yugoslavia where Ameri-can and Russian armies were pushing hard for a cleanup. Germany's biggest holding is Norway, approximately 125,000 square miles of rugged terrain and difficult coast line.
