Last April, as the agents of many nations assembled at the Yalta conference, Mrs. Eleanor Roosevelt expressed a not exuberant desire to see the United States well represented by at least one woman in the United Nations organization and this wish, it is interpreted as a personal nomination of herself to a place on the public payroll.

Recent developments have confirmed the wish. Washington Post, for President Truman daily ordered her, the senate confirmed the nomination and this vibrant politician, as adherent to millions of American women as she is adaptable to other millions, she felt "deeply honored" but positively refrained from claiming any mandate to speak for American womanhood. In fact, Mrs. Roosevelt did not even claim to govern and qualifications for the position and the first her perfection "largely" in the future, her late husband laid the foundation of the UNO.

## Fire Destroys McClain Home At Castleford

CASTLEFORD, Jan. 29.—A four house one mile west of here owned by Maurice Guertel was demolished by fire Monday afternoon. The late, Mel McClain, was inside a portion of the house at the time and did not suffer the flames.

The house was estimated at \$2000 and the furniture, all of which was destroyed except a refrigerator, estimated at \$1000. Origin of the blaze was undetermined. Debris of an explosion from a gas stove in the building hampered fire fighting activities.

The fire, which the department made a run to the scene, but the structure was enveloped in flames by the time it arrived.

Mr. Roosevelt, of course, has an inherited personal fortune and an income from her journalistic career established as a by-product of the presidency in the first frank commercial exploitation of the office of a President's wife in American history, she also enjoys, for the rest of her life, the income from the estate of her late husband, a millionaire by inheritance.

As widow of President Roosevelt enjoys a special privilege by comparison with other widows, the rank and members of congress engaged for special duties. A travel officer of the armed services who is called back to help the government in some administrative job, such as General Bradley's post as head of the veterans' administration, cannot draw his pension in addition to his pay. The pension stops during such employment. And the act of congress permitting the appointment of Mrs. Roosevelt to a job paying \$12,000, in addition to her pension of \$10,000, specifically states that "no member of the senate or house of representatives or officer of the United States who is designated a representative or alternate to the general assembly shall be permitted to receive compensation" of \$12,000 a year.

The act authorizing the \$10,000 pension to Mrs. Roosevelt was introduced by Representative John Lusk of Michigan, a Democrat, chairman of the committee on invalid pensions. It was referred to his committee and he presented a favorable report supported by a letter from General Frank T. Hines, then chief of the veterans' administration, who wrote that there were many precedents but added: "It has not been the practice of the veterans' administration to comment on the propriety of proposed legislation of this type."

Among the recipients of such \$10,000 pensions are some widows who would seem to have no need. Mrs. Edith Boling Wilson, widow of Woodrow, is commonly well known to be wealthy in her own right and Mrs. Edith C. Roosevelt, the widow of Theodore, had not only an estate but a large fortune, who, in a pinch, could have maintained their mother as most women. In case of need, too, a little obligation to do, regarding this duty, a privilege. Franklin D. Roosevelt, too, also, could have made it unnecessary for the taxpayers to support their mother.

A long roster of widows of Presidents, beginning with Martha Washington, have received the franking privilege but Mrs. Eleanor Roosevelt is the first one to whom the grant amounts to more than a sentimental gesture providing for the earnings of a little personal staff. Mrs. Eleanor Roosevelt maintains a political and business office in New York and her rank is applicable to tons of the propaganda of the political action committee and the correspondence incidental to the commercial business of running a newspaper column and a magazine department. Legitimate journalists in the same pay, they pay their postage themselves. And this is not to forget the \$10,000 given by Mr. Truman to a syndicated columnist and commercial writer who had lost considerable money.

The American taxpayer, including the war veterans, wounded and all, have been much more generous to the widow of a military President, herself well provided for, than they will be to the destitute, invalid
