An easing of several major strikes, including the vast steel dispute, appeared imminent today as President Truman cancelled his planned vacation in Florida while government and labor officials strove to bring a quick end to the 19-day-old steel walkout.

A formal White House statement mentioned only "the immediate critical situation in volving problems requiring his personal attention" as the reason for cancellation. White House aides, however, told reporters that the labor crisis and the related wage-price policy question were involved in the decision.






