Nuptials With Japs Offered By Canadians

WINNIPEG, Man. Feb. 27 (UP)—Letters proposing marriage to Japanese girls who are accredited for deportation have been received by the "New Canadian" Canada's only Japanese language newspaper, it was disclosed today.

The writers, from scattered parts of the country, emphasized they were serious in their intention of marrying the Japanese women.

"I have been 22 years old now," wrote "that Japanese woman during and don't ask silly questions about it."

He said he was tired of being a bachelor and would marry a "nice, clean Japanese girl" and "kill two birds with one stone" by leaving her from being a wife.

A 24-year-old bachelor who said he favored "decisive" women sought an introduction to a Japanese wife of similar "decisive" character, 20 and 30 without dependents.

A merchant named "John" said he had often visited Japan and remembered "the good times and recall that they were."

Another writer said he was a "British kook" but objected to the deportation order and "would be very grateful if I could be of some help to one Japanese woman."

He added, by conclusion:

"I think if I can get a girl of means, that would make it much easier."

A somewhat similar practical viewpoint was taken by a middle-aged business man, who said he wanted a "social and business partner." He preferred, he said, a girl who was "strong, healthy, and we could work and play together."

Still another would-be suitor suggested a "mass marriage" movement should be launched to "keep out Canadian girls, Japs of all ages at home."

To prove that he was serious, he offered to come to Winnipeg and have the girl "look me over for approval purposes."

SAN FRANCISCO, Feb. 27.—China has one of the world's largest armies — few today know exactly how large.

Jerome Man Now Declared Dead by U. S.

JEROME, Feb. 27.—Word received here Tuesday morning from the war department said that Sgt. George R. Langer, 26, is now officially dead, relatives here stated.

Sergeant Langer, a rural unit carrier, here before entering the service, disappeared Oct. 10, approximately 120 miles off the coast of New Jersey when the plane in which he was serving apparently crashed into the water. He received as a gunner on a B-24 bomber which had been ferrying deodorized to Japan.

It was reported a few days after the crash that the body of the dead man was recovered from Langer's plane. The search was started immediately but the only evidence found was an overturned oil can, three oxygen tanks and oil spots on the outer of the water to indicate the crash end of the plane and to the ocean. The search was continued for two days without success. An orange sea marker, such as are used when pilots are forced to bail out at sea. The body of the man was recovered in August, 1945 and buried at Union Army camp before the end of the war. His plane then was reported as having been recovered by the Air Service, now scheduled for 7:30 each Wednesday.

Burley Adding 4 New Rooms Onto Hospital

BURLEY, Feb. 27.—Because of overcrowded conditions, four new rooms are being added to the Colgate hospital. These rooms, with facilities for eight patients, will provide only temporary relief for overcrowded facilities of the hospital.

The hospital, which was built in 1934, was originally planned for a capacity of 15 patients. By reducing the number of private rooms to a minimum, the present capacity of the hospital is twenty patients. However, in emergencies, more have been accommodated by using the X-ray room and putting beds in the halls. During 1945, the daily average of patients was 18.2, and the yearly total was 712.

The use of the hospital has increased greatly during the past three years. In 1945, 548 patients were admitted with a daily average of 15.8 patients in the hospital. The following year, 638 patients were admitted with a daily average of 16.8 patients, while in 1945 the total number admitted climbed to 712 and the daily average was 18.2 patients.

By comparison to a similar period in 1944-45, already 111 more patients have been admitted from the period of Oct. 1 to Feb. 24.
