20,000 Japs Hide on Isles Over Pacific

TOKYO, March 20.—More than 20,000 Japanese soldiers are hidden in Japanese Pacific islands, still unaware that the war has ended, the newspaper Asahi said today. It based its estimate on stories brought home by recently repatriated soldiers.

Most still hiding are in the Philippines, the Solomon, New Guinea and Guadalcanal. Some 200, led by a staff officer, remain in secret caves on Guam, conquered by Americans 10 months ago, the newspaper reported.

In the Philippines at least 4,000 Japs in jungle. Recently a Japanese repatriation ship, posing as an unarmored mine, of 200 Japs, sighted a group of Japanese soldiers making fire.

Sheriff's deputies Tuesday night recovered a coupe which had been abandoned one-quarter mile east of the steel bridge at Murtaugh.

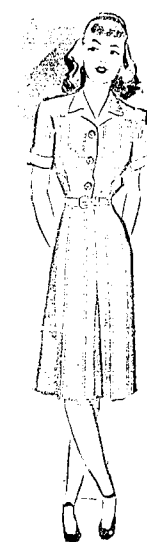
They identified it as one reported stolen at 11:20 p. m. Monday from Jim Kasper, route 1, Twin Falls, who had left it parked near the park hotel here.
