# Cowboys Won't Be Called 'Dem Bums' Even With 2 Ex-Brooklyn Players on Team

The Twin Falls Cowboys won't be called "Dem Bums"—the Brooklyn Dodgers' nickname—because the team's players will have two former players from that National League club in their lineup this season.

That was the opinion of President Maury Dorrer of the Cowboys last night after it was called to his attention the Wanderers had a pair of "ex-Bums" as their pitcher.

The two are Frank Lamanske, the southpaw pitcher who last year with the Bums, and Jack Radtke, the infielder who jumped from the armed forces a few days ago into the Cowboy camp at Merced, Calif.

Nearly every one knows the Lamanske and with Brooklyn for the greater part of one season just before he became the property of the Bums club. But it was left up to Tom Johnson, reporter for the morning edition of the Times-News, to reveal that Radtke was with the Dodgers in the history of Bums three-man who were best known as the "Tidelines Boys."

Several persons closely connected with Bums league baseball doubt Johnson's statement that Radtke played with Brooklyn. They offered only a challenge to the Times-News reporter, who immediately phoned into the club and sure enough there was Radtke with the morning edition of the Times-News, Dodge, was back in 1936.

Johnson's research revealed that during the latter part of 1936 season Radtke got into many games for Brooklyn, subbing at second, shortstop and third base.

You see, Radtke played in Bums while Johnson was a reporter there and the latter made the discovery that the player formerly was with Brooklyn.

At the time he questioned Bums manager Jim Keeney why Radtke was with a C league team when just a few years previous he had been in the majors, Keeney said that the infielder had a batting weakness that the major league pitchers discovered and which eventually sent him down into the minors.

However, that weakness wasn't apparent while he played in the Pioneer league back in 1934 for he was quite the sensation, both in batting and fielding.
