WASHINGTON, May 15 (P)—Childless men 28 through 9 years old came back into the draft picture today as Presi-lent Turman's choice of "the lesser of two evils" kept selec-ive service legally slive but crippled. For the moment, however, only men 20-25 will be in-

Mr. Truman chose last night to sign a 46-day stop-gap extension of the draft law—but with an outright ban on inductions of either fathers or teen-age youths—rather than let the act expire at midnight.

Dak, abandoned his threat to talk selective service to death.
