SELLING BUSINESS In a roul-searching session not long ago, Keineth Patrick of the General Electric pub-licity stati addressed a group of advertising men on some shortcomings of their two pro-fessions. He noted, among other things, the misconception of the whole American busi-ness structure which is particularly prevalent among students of all ages and their teach-ers. And he made this profoundly true obser-vation:

Most Americans are conscious of the pleasant and unmatched fruits of living that the free en-terprise system brings. But they suspect the people who operate the system. The very term "free enterprises" has come to be somewhat scornful and opprobrious. In many industries the lack of common purpose, sympathy and understanding be-trong the system of the system man-gement and public. One result is a vague groping toward state socialism and more gov-ernment control, though the groper has fit soundreis that and class of human beings big businessmen are certainly no more vil-lations than farmers of labor leaders of school teachers. Then why their unhappy Berbanes one reason is that alt the millions

Jainous than farmers or labor leaders or cachool teachers. Then why their unhappy reputations? Perhaps one reason is that all the millions spent by business on advertising and pub-licity doesn't teil the most important story. Perhaps there is too much attention given to the financial statements and pub charts show-ing how the company's dollar is spent. Per-haps, an Mr. Patrick says, business ought to speak over the back fence instead of from an lvory towr. In spite of all the high-pried drives and campaigns of business advertising. the anti-free enterprises are much the better alogan-eers. You don't need documented priot to shout "monopoly" "greedy capitalist" tertainly is effective. So many Americans have the idea that profit is a sin; that the men who run busi-nesses, make profits and create jobs are ef-lecient but uncrastvorthy; that our high liv-ing standard, high employment and high the theorem.

The job for business, then, would seem to be a broad, continuing, atmost informal pro-gram of education and explanation. This might include a declaration of humane be-liefs and good accomplishments, backed by more emphasis on self-regulation. It wouldn't be necessary to get mad or out-shoul the op-position, but just to tell the story simply, humanly and honestly through all mediums of expression from a full-page ad to a side-walk conversation. The free enterprise system is challenged as never before. If more people really under-stood it, surely more would approve and sup-port it. The job for business, then, would seem to be
