## 2 Nurses Flying to Aid Pair

The services of two nurses now located in Phoenix, Ariz., were finally secured for the care of twin boys who are polio patients through the Red Cross Thursday. Mrs. Vic Goertzen, chairman of the women's division of the Twin Falls Infirmary Foundation, announced today.

Information as to when they may arrive was not available until after an appeal was issued Thursday afternoon by Mrs. Helen Baker, executive secretary of the Red Cross for blankets containing 60 per cent wool and for a washing and wringer, this paraphernalia was secured for the two polio patients. The twin boys, who are polio patients, are being treated at the Phoenix hospital. Mrs. Goertzen said that the two Arizona nurses, whose names are not yet available, would be flown here by Red Cross airplane on Friday Saturday. Expense of the flight and responsibility for obtaining living quarters for the two patients will be assumed by the Red Cross, respectively.

# Rescue Aided Helicopter to Leap to Fame

WASHINGTON, Sept. 27 (AP)—The helicopter, upward against the odds, leapt to fame in Newfoundland last weekend. And now the government has given its okay to helicopter taxicab service in Cleveland.

Actually, the rescue of the Newfoundland plane crash survivors and the coming aerial taxi service represent pretty routine stuff for the flying windmills. But they dramatize what the aviation industry expects of the queer looking contraptions within a short time.

**War Role Small**

The helicopter's wartime role was small compared to that of the conventional airplane, but it filled in gaps that a fixed-wing craft couldn't touch in China and Burma, Alaska and Labrador, the helicopter went into "inaccessible" places to rescue downed fliers.

One large bus line has established helicopters in the hope of ordered a shuttle service, and the civil aeronautics board—whose examiners approved the Cleveland service—has numerous other applications for a variety of passenger and cargo services.

Some department stores have applied for permission to use helicopters in their own delivery service. The bureau of fisheries will use them for locating schools of fish, Canadian prospectors are trying them for covering rough terrain.

**Helicopters Expensive**

The machines are expensive and require more skill than conventional aircraft. One industry spokesman estimates that out of 500 or 600 accredited helicopter pilots in the United States only 100 are qualified to fly the commercially used.

United Aircraft sells a four-place model for \$48,500. Bell Aircraft is building smaller helicopters at somewhat lower prices.

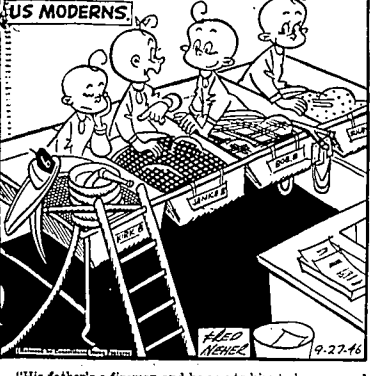

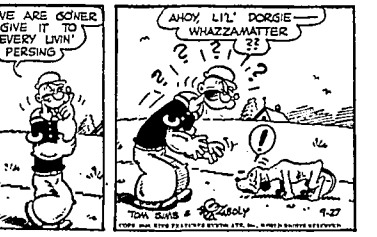

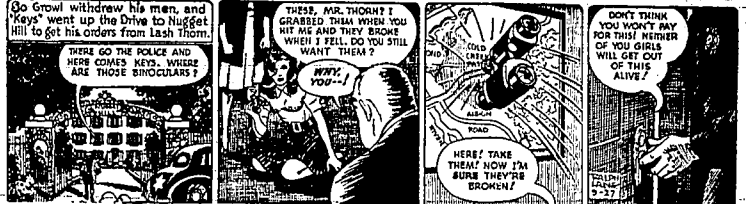

At the time of Mr. Roosevelt's death he was due to him on his salary as President. He held \$76,150 in government securities, including U. S. treasury bonds, tax savings certificates and was bonded.

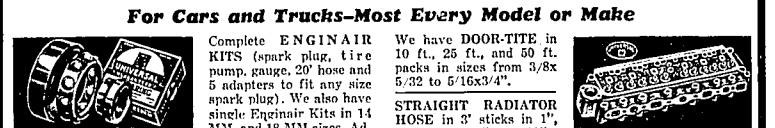
