Czech Pastor Recalls War At Filer Meet

FILER, Nov. 21 — Saved from death by a member of the gendarmes, the Rev. Václav Vancura, Czechoslovakian Methodist pastor, said that this German told him, "Don't be afraid, I am a Methodist!"

Speaking to 100 persons at the Methodist church family fellowship dinner here tonight, the central European minister explained that this incident occurred after his brother had escaped from Czechoslovakia to England and thus caused the lives of all relatives to be held forfeit in reprisal by the Germans.

Although the Czechs are grateful to the Russians for freeing their homeland, the German conquerors, they do not allow the Russians to influence their lives, said the Rev. Mr. Vancura.

But for the packers of food, medicine and clothing which were sent from America through Geneva to Czechoslovakia during the war years, thousands of children would have perished, he declared.

The speaker also studied in the U. S. at Oberlin college. O. He was introduced by the Rev. G. C. Hersh, Twin Falls, district superintendent of the Methodist church, at the meeting presided over by the Rev. J. B. Wilford, Filer Methodist pastor.

Vicious Dogs Ravage Sheep Near Here, Leave 46 Injured

Sheep-killing dogs attacked a band of 1,500 feeder lambs sometime after 2 a. m. Sunday, left 46 slashed and torn wethers behind them. Of these injured animals, six had to be killed by their owner, Charles H. Colner, Hansen, and he said Thursday that it looks like "five or six more" will have to be dispatched.

The sheep were feeding on an 80-acre range belonging to Floyd Bandy, one-half mile south of the Twin Falls sugar factory when the dogs attacked. The only herdman watching the flock emerged from his shack for a look at the sheep about 2 a. m., saw nothing away and went back to bed, according to Colner.

Some hours later, when the depredations were discovered the herdman found one maimed animal huddled in a private garage at one end of the half-mile stretch of pasture, a second in a garage abutting on the other end of the track. The rest of the wounded sheep were scattered about the field or bunched in the center.

The sheep-breeder declared himself unable to estimate accurately how many dogs were in the pack of sheep-killers though he guessed five or six.
