#### THE WILL OF THE PEOPLE

"The fact still remains that the law of our land is the will of the majority of our citizens reflected through the Juries in our court system."

That statement, made by Police Chief Howard W. Olliette, is a significant appraisal of the open disregard for some of the laws in Idaho.

He clied one of these laws which he des-cribes as "jokers." It pertains to permissive possession of liquor and reads as follows; "Any person may lawfully possess and store

cholic liquors lawfully purchased for the

greats."

It takes no sharpster to figure out how our so-called locker and social clubs came into being as a result of this masterpiece of jurisprudence. It is only natural that "locker clubs are the 'things in which to "store' clubs are the 'things in which to "store' gard their patrons as "guests."

With laws as filmy as this there can be little hope for stringent enforcement, even if such hope exists.

The real question in Idaho, however, goes back to the fundamental truth expressed by

If our legislatures are going to take a half-hearted stand in their enactments of liquor controls, and the public in turn takes a similar attitude, our juries will "reflect" that disregard for laws which no longer are respected by a majority of the people.

In one respect Idaho has been playing catrich by hiding its head from reality. One would think the issue was whether Idaho should be wet or dry. Actually no such issue exists because Idaho is already legally wet. Anyone who wants to buy liquor legally may do no.

do so.

The only real question involved is whether liquor should be sold by the drink, which already is common practice throughout the state and will continue so as long as our state legislatures, our juries and a majority of the

reguatures, our juries and a majority of the people themselves lean approvingly in that direction.

And the locker and social clubs which flour-fan under this system of hyporisy, will con-tinue to reap their wealth—uniteensed and uncontrolled.

FROM BAD TO WORSE

Indications are that members of the state legislature are approaching a compromise which will amount to legalizing liquor-by-the-drink on a local option basis.

In other words, it appears as if the legislators have decided on the easy way out. They will pass the buck so as to get themselves off the pollitical hot spot.
