

Last August, Sen. Henry Dworsthak requested the department of justice to investigate reasons for prevailing prices of gasoline in Idaho, inasmuch as they are substantially higher than in surrounding states.

In his latest report to Senator Dworshak, the attorney general has given the people of Idaho at least a partial answer to their question.







