Soviet Press Lashes U. S. Broadcasting

MOSCOW, April 11 (UP)—The Soviet press condemned the American state department broadcasts to Russia today as "not the voice of the American people but an echo of reactionary voices."

The first Soviet attack on the American broadcasts appeared in Culture and Life, published by the Communist party propaganda committee. It was written by Ilya Shorobov, one of the Soviet Union's leading writers, and occupied two-thirds of a page.

Until today the American broadcasts had received no mention in the Soviet press.

Shorobov cited numerous examples and lifted many quotes from the broadcasts to show their "falsehood." Amongst them he gave what he called the true picture of the circumstances on which the American radio had attempted to mislead the Soviet people.

The broadcasts in Russian were begun Feb. 17. Reception in Moscow was had at first but later improved sharply. A state department spokesman in Washington said the Munich relay transmitter had been "sabotaged," causing the broadcasts to be heard toward South America instead of the Soviet Union.

BOISE, April 11 (UP)—Barney Glavin, Twin Falls, has been elected to the board of directors of the Idaho Power company, taking the place left vacant by the death of E. J. Conrader, also of Twin Falls, last Sept. 17.

Glavin is Republican state representative from Twin Falls county and was speaker of the 1947 house of representatives.
