The mine leader's agreement, reversing a previous stand, raised the possibility of avoiding a crippling strike in coal industry when the government rolinquishes control of the pits this summer. The United Mine Workers traditionally have refused to work without a contract.

The Southern Coal Froducers association, representing about 25 per cent of the nation's bituminous production, balked at industry-wide bargaining and asked for separate negotiations.

Lewis replied that he wanted a chance to discuss the southerners' request with his policy committee before giving an answer.

FIRST RESPONSIBILITY

America's first responsibility in world affairs, says Commerce Secretary Harriman,
"is to meet our responsibilities to ourselves
... our primary task is to maintain the productivity and health of our own economy."

Few Americans or friends of America will care to quarrel with that statement. It is to the world's interest as well as our own that we maintain a sound economy, high production, and a living standard that promotes health, contentment and industrial peace.
For, as Mr. Harriman pointed out, we are about the only nation today that can provide a good life for its own people and still help other peoples of the world to help themselves. What we should do, then, seems clear

what we should do, to nelp themselves.
What we should do, to hen, seems clear
enough. But how we should do it, and to
what extent, is not so simple. At what point
can we say that our first responsibility is
safely discharged? How much attention and

world help itself?

Perplexing questions like those are at the root of some of the current disagreements in Wanhington. The perplexity is evident in the difference of opinions in the house and senate — \$150,000,000 worth of difference — over how much American money should be appropriated for foreign relief.

There is binartisan arcement on foreign

appropriated for foreign relief.

There is bipartisan agreement on foreign policy. That fortunate example of statesmanship cannot be discounted. But there is no such unanimity on economic policy. It is difficult to separate these two policies now. It will be more difficult, if not impossible to separate them when our economy is set to work to put our foreign policy into practice. Since separation seems doubtful, it will be necessary for congress to develop bipartisan agreement on political-economic policy and operation. This, in turn, will require a better understanding with the executive department on specific steps that must be taken.

There should be a clear understanding.

There should be a clear understanding on how much of our relief is to be humanitarian, and how much frankly political. Few, if any, congressmen would delibertely withhold food from hungry people because their government is communist-dominated. At the same few would care to see American food funds misappropriated to further that

and funds misappropriated to further that domination.

America must agree either to risk misuse of American aid in Russia's neighboring countries, or to hazard bad feelings and a tighter closing of the iron curtain by staying out of them. The most expert opinion available must contribute to the decision of how much money is needed to ease the world's economic plight and restore the world trade which is necessary to continued American prosperity and safety.

If these questions are decided on a basis of personal prejudice or partisan politics it can scarcely fall to do this country and the world great damage. The American government can best meet its first responsibility by giving this problem some straight, realistic thinking.
