



HOMES, HABITS AND FIRES The nation's fire loss has been increasing steadily in the last seven years, with the per taplita loss increasing from a prewar \$1.95 to \$4.01 in 1946. This year the National Fire Fortcetion association fears that the figure will rise to \$5, and the total fire loss through-out the country to \$700,060,000. Those would be disheartening statistics under normal conditions. But with the pre-ent bousing shortage, they become alarming. With millions seeking more adequate living quarters-or any quarters at all--the des-truction of one dwelling by fire amounts to the loss of two.
