"It was just an accident," said Jesse Wyse, driver of the tractor hauling the sleigh, whose own son and daughter survived, said he was halfway across the tracks when he saw the train bearing down. "I just froze stiff," he said. Wyse was unhurt in the accident, but he was under a doctor's care.

The Nebraska senator expressed this sentiment in commenting on plans of Senator Frank P. Ramsey, D., Minn., to introduce legislation authorizing a department to experiment with rationing in the event of an emergency. Ramsey said he would have to enact still another law to get actual rationing under way.

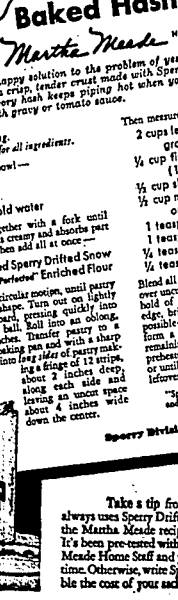

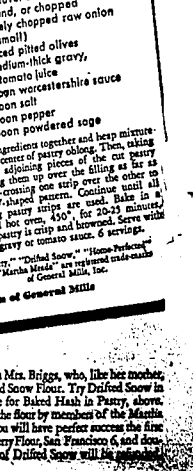

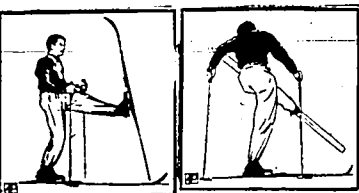
