are unable to complete terminal to terminal runs and motorists have been ordered off many highways.

In north Idaho, students of University of Idaho at Moscow were driven from a veterans' village. At Princeton, the water was two feet deep in the main street last night. Children near Point were driving livestock out of the valleys.

A number of roads were severed in northeastern Washington and the Evergreen route through the Columbia river gorge was only partially open because of landslides. Elberton, Wash., was isolated when a bridge was flooded over. At Pullman, Wash., all female students of Washington State college were working on dikes around a veterans' trailer village where 300 students and their families live.

There were reports also that winter wheat plantings in eastern Washington and Oregon were badly eroded by rain but there was no official estimate of damage.

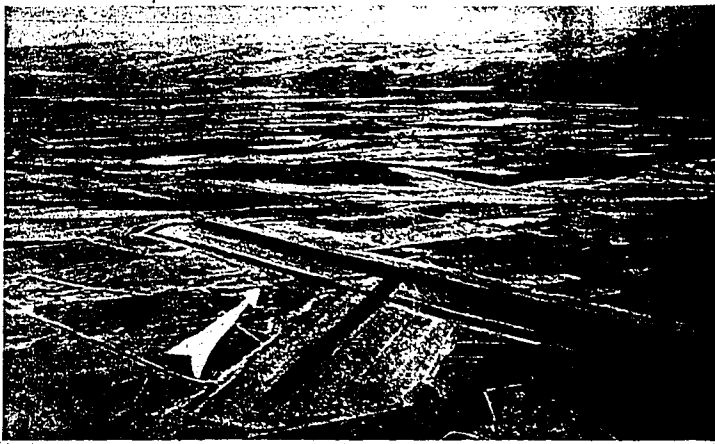
Most of the stricken area in Oregon centered around Eugene, where the river and tributaries are now receding rapidly. At Salem, in the heart of the middle valley, Red Cross and army authorities directed evacuations from low-land areas. Residents were moved last night. More and more rural roads were flooding hourly, state police were directing traffic was halted on the Pacific highways—paralleling both sides of the Willamette.

The Southern Pacific railroad was prepared to operate a passenger shuttle service linking West Salem and the capital proper when the highway bridge is closed as expected late today. The rail bridge is above the expected crest.

Motor traffic bound north and south through Oregon between Washington and California was directed to The Dalles, Ore., and California highways east of the Cascade mountains.

The seven days of continuous rain, which brought on the sudden flood, had not entirely subsided, but the weather forecast was for lighter rains.

He said that if proposed plans "work out" the airport should be in commercial use within five months. A shorter length of time before Empire and United Air Lines may first land their scheduled flights here depends upon eight factors as will aeronautics administration approval of pending contracts and availability of materials, he said.
