President's "Cold War" Budget Creaks Over 39 Billion for '49; Old Congress Wrecks Its Axe

WASHINGTON, Jan. 12 (UP)—President Truman today sent to a Republican congress, which is sure to rip it apart, a "cold war" budget for spending more than \$39,668,000,000 in the fiscal year 1949.

Increase to \$770,000 from \$100,000 as the limitation of funds for reconstruction in connection with the postwar pumping division at Minneapolis was urged by President Truman in his proposed budget.

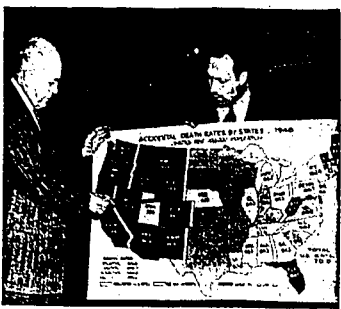
