

RIGHT, BUT STILL 'WRONG'

There is nothing new in the Soviet government's efforts to remove all western in-fluence from Russian minds. Every so often we read that an author, playwright, com-poser or other artist has been reprimanded— or worse—for succumbing to "bourgeois" in-fluences.

But now these efforts have been extended into a less familiar field, and one that concerns the western nations more closely. According to Will Lissner, a New York Times reporter, the Soviet union's ace economist is now in the doghouse. The reasons are interesting, but not very encouraging.

The economist is Dr. Eugen Varga, a Hungarian-born Marxist who has lived in Russia since 1929. He was Premier Stalin's personal economic adviser during the war. Before that he had been the Communist International's economic expert. The account of his fail from grace was found in official Soviet publications which recently came into Mr. Lissner's possession.

Dr. Varga's principal sin, it seems, was his conclusion that a crisis was not imminent in capitalist countries; that there was not account in capitalist countries; that there was not account in the state of the state of

tion. The most cheerful interpretation of this incident is that the Varga findings are out of line with Soviet propaganda. The Stalinstassen interview may or not have been printed in the Russian press. We don't know, But Dr. Varga's views were contained in a book that was available to the Russian public.

Mr. Lissner's information is that Dr. Varga refused to say his views were wrong, even when he was called on the carpet. But his opinion that capitalism was not tottering and that a showdown was not inevitable ran counter to the present party line. So he had to be branded as "wrong."

The other interpretation is that the Soviet government has decided, against good economic advice, that it will not cooperate with capitalism. Such a course is senseless, and dangerous. But, unhapply, the trend of Russian policy unless it is largely buff, supports the second interpretation.






