THE COST OF GOVERNMENT
To know yourself, it has been said, is the beginning of all wi-dom.
According to Mix Yook, executive manuser of the Associated Taxpayers of Idaho, "multiple languages across the nation, shoefully the soating rosts of local government, are applying that adapte to their communities to determine whether they're governing itemselves wheely and communically."

If ever such interest becomes aroused throughout the United States we will have better government all around. And until the people themselves start showing such an interest, the professional politicians will continue taking us for a ride.

As Mr. Yost has pointed out, there is ample reason for the average American citizen to become concerned. He cites, for instance, the fact that the aggregated annual cast, the fact that the aggregated annual cast of local government in the United States has soared from 5 billion dollars in 1946 to 11 billion dollars in 1947.

Bringing these facts still more closely into focuse—right down to our own state of Idaho—comparisons are even more interesting. In 1941 the total of local, state and federal direct taxes was \$37,289,808. By 1947 the same total figure had climbed to 118 million dollars. For that same period, state taxes in Idaho increased do per cent, county taxes \$54 per cent, school taxes 77 per cent, cities and villages \$59 per cent, there districts \$2 per cent.

This is reason enough why more attention

This is reason enough why more attention should be given to detailed analysis of the expenditures of public funds. The taxpayers must demand that some accounting be made

must demand that some accounting be made for all this lavish spending trend over which there seems to be no control. In trying to place the blame for this ever-mounting cost of government, we should not overlook one contributing factor which could easily escape our attention. Outmoded methods, although honestly administered in many instances, but nevertheless inceptly at-tuned to the times, are costing the taxpayers millions of dollars every year. We often hear it said that we have to find a new source of government revenue. Ac-

of source of government revenue. Ac-, as Mr. Yost contends, there is only ource for all taxes and that is the taxer himself. A new source is only another of adding more of a load on him.
