#### OUR HIGHWAY DEPARTMENT

Although the advisory council working th the statewide highway study commit-e has no word in making final decisions, e expressions made by individual members council at the first meeting of the committee in Boise this past week at least give strong indication of what changes may

give strong indication of what changes may be found necessary.

In this analysis of Idalio's highway problems, being sponsored by the State Chamber of Commerce, the ndvisory council is set up to provide the technical information required for the study. The council is composed of nine members, mostly city, county, state and federal engineers.

The following statements made by members of the advisory council to assist the study and executive committees in working out procedure for the statewide analysis speak for themselves:

James Reid, Idaho state director of high-ways—"For some time I have recognized the need for such a study. I will have my aupport. Our highway department is faced with many problems and is working under laws that are obsolete. We can't change officials every two years and get a long range planchat are obsolete. We can't change blitchast every two years and get a long range plan-ning program worked out." Edward W. Equals, director of the highway

ning program worked out."
Edward W. Equals, director of the highway planning aurvey—"Our organization was acreated in 1936 under Joint aponsorship of the state of John on the bureau of highways. During 12 years of research we have sen agrowing need for coordinating activities. There is no comprehensive system either for long range planning or for distributing our taxes for road building purposes. We need a better system for nilocation of road funds. Lee Huggins, district engineer, U. 8 public roads administration—"I am glad to know that a study is under way for an adequate road system in John."
William Jughes, city engineer of Lewiston—"I daho has next to the lowest pud high-company and the property of the pr

directors in 25 years. Oregon has had only one!"

J. D. Sinems, engineer, Twin Falls highway district—"I feel the people have lost faith in the state highway department. Our read laws should be revamped...! Delive the commission form of highway administration would place the department back in the condidence of the people."

L. B. Jordan, chairman, interim legislative committee on bus and truck licenses and fees—"If we raise more money (for road building purposes) where is the money going? What is our highway program? Perhaps we should borrow a page from studies by other states, California for instance. In the matter of taxation we are set up on an old disecfee system which is obsolete. We should ax on the basis of the use motor vehicles make of our roads." the basis of the use motor vehicles four roads."

Orval Anderson, regional engineer, U. S. forest service, Odgen—"It seems impossible to build and maintain roads efficiently unless the highway department personnel is taken out of politics. Consider the turnover of personnel. What company would think of changing its board of directors every two years?"

Then, as an after thought, Mr. Reid, Idaho's highway director, made this significant observation—"What happens? You have an election. The highway department employes are let down. They have an 'I'll be off the payroll—don't care' attitude. It's hard for the engineers to get results under these conditions. Then you can add to all that the material and equipment that are lost and destroyed under this system."

There is the picture as it is viewed by qualified observers who are closest to the scene. When you take into consideration that \$17,-500,000 was spent on highways in Idaho in 1946 by the state, the counties, highway districts and cities and villages, and you wonder whether we got value received for all this money, these expressions may at least suggest an explanation. The study group, it would seem, has every opportunity to perform a major service.






