U.S. Housing Act Gets House Okay **Despite President**

WASHINGTON, June 18 (P)—The house today passed a housing hill shorn of slum clearance or public housing provisions and denounced by President Truman as "the real estate lobby's" bill.

It sent the bill to the senate, which previously had passed the so-called T-E-W long-range housing bill containing slum clearance and public housing features. House passage earns after 40 minutes of debate.

James C. Petrillo played some variations on an original theme for the American Federation of Musicians convention in Asbury Park.

N. J. Last March, when he lifted his ban on union music for television and renewed his contract with the networks, he explained that the broadcasters "simply said that they couldn't give us more men and more money, and I look them at their word."

But the AFR president told the convention that he had falled to get them more work and morey for grimmer reasons. He said no union is strong enough to win a strike today. The Tatt-Hartley law has now made a contract as binding on a union as on anyone else, and an employer can sue for breach of contract and resulting damages. But he cannot "sue you for anything."
