## West Nations Sift Proposal to 'Run' Berlin's Blockade

BERLIN, July 19 (U.P.)—The military governors of western Germany conferred here for four hours today a few hours after high sources in Frankfurt reported the allies were considering a plan to send armored convoys through the Russian blockade of this city.

Gen. Henry said, however, as he left the conference room at British headquarters that "we did not discuss the Berlin situation."

The governors, their deputies and advisers met to discuss details of the proposed government for western Germany.

ARLINGTON NATIONAL CEMETERY, July 19 (U.P.)—General of the Army John J. Pershing was buried with a hero's honors today in a hill-top grave surrounded by thousands of the dead he led as living men to victory in World War I.

Near neighbors of the unknown soldier of World War I, the best known soldier of that conflict went to rest after the greatest outpouring of honors ever bestowed by the nation upon a dead military chieftain.

Three others were hospitalized and a fourth person was injured slightly.

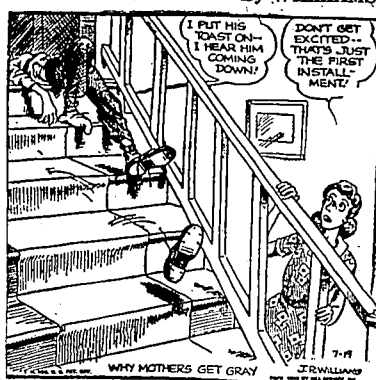

LOS ANGELES, July 19 — Evidence of what may be the oldest human habitation in North America has been unearthed at a prehistoric desert campsite 100 miles northeast of Los Angeles.

An expedition from the Southern Museum, headed by veteran archeologist, Dr. Mark R. Harrington, has uncovered a series of post-holes which he believes were left by the poles of a 2,000 to 10,000-year-old pinto culture house.

They laid out in the shape of a rectangle about seven feet wide and 12 feet long, the holes outlined a one-room dwelling. Pinto rock arrowheads, arrow points and tools were found on the floor, indicating that the find is ancient, and not a specimen of the modern Paiute Indians, Dr. Harrington said.

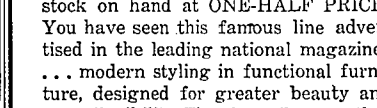

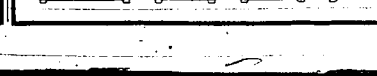
