Pomp for Royalty Expected to Go With Holland's New Ruler

THE HAGUE (AP)—A lot of the pomp and ceremony expected to be tossed out after Princess Juliana succeeds her mother, Wilhelmina as queen of the Netherlands on Sept. 6.

The 30-year reign of the first Queen of the House of Orange went by the book. The 84-year-old Wilhelmina, who is abdicating because of age and fatigue, died in for pomp and ceremony, but she was always a stickler for royal adherence to correct form.

In her palace of Het Loos, near Apeldoorn, to which she will retire on a government pension, the old school Queen insisted on correct protocol for her subjects and exacting protocol. She has made frequent inspection tours of the grounds to make sure things were running right.

The difference between the two queens is to be seen in their upbringing. Wilhelmina, who came into the line of succession with the death of her father when she was four, succeeded to the throne at 10 and began ruling at 18, was trained as carefully as a ballerina...

But Wilhelmina was to it that her only child had a more normal upbringing, one shared with other children and had a chance to study at Leyden university...

As a constitutional monarch, Queen Juliana has not been in a position to rule, but she has been no mere figurehead. More than one minister has left the palace red-faced with embarrassment after being taken over the coals by the queen...

Wilhelmina has always been more popular with her people than her ministers. Once, when advised by a minister to try to quell a strike because she was growing too stout, she replied, "But I must have the strength to cope with my ministers."

It was because she took her job as monarch so seriously that Wilhelmina decided to abdicating she felt her strength had been impaired. "A younger person must take over," she said.

He served as a royal air force officer during the war, returned to the Netherlands as commander of the forces of the interior and since has served as an inspector general of the Netherlands army.

With Juliana's accession to the throne, 10-year-old Princess Beatrix, oldest daughter of the late Princess Juliana and Prince Bernhard, becomes heiress apparent. She is due to become queen one day unless an son is born to the royal couple.
