

# Confident Dewey Studying Cabinet Choices; ruman Assails GOP "Maneuvers"

EN ROUTE WITH TRUMAN, Oct. 25 (UP)—President Truman, making his final campaign swing, said today the Republicans were trying to defeat him by giving aid to the "third party" in the presidential campaign.

In an article in the Chicago Tribune for a major address, the President said Republicans "have been pretending that my administration has been friendly to communists."

"I believe," President said, "that if you tell a big enough lie enough times that everyone will believe it."

"Doing Everything"

He said the communists are doing everything in their power to get elected by taking over the Progressive party.

In Indiana, he said, the communists had financed the party's setting on the ballot.

"And over across the line in Illinois," he continued, "the Republicans are trying their best to get the Illinois vote by getting the party and the Republicans had even taken the fight to the supreme court."

The President evidently referred to efforts by the Illinois Attorney General to get the state to obtain United States supreme court approval of efforts by the progressives to get the party on the ballot.

Mr. Truman repeated charges that he had supported Gov. Thomas E. Dewey, Republican presidential candidate, in a campaign against the Roosevelt administration. He accused Dewey of uttering only platitudes, and said that Dewey means only "to get elected."

He said that Dewey had started his "Democratic Party" to get elected to the White House in 1940 when Mr. Roosevelt was the good-for-nothing 80th president.

Mr. Truman and the President, and their daughter Margaret were on the campaign special's rear platform when the train pulled out, a group of women near the tracks pointed to Margaret and said:

"Make her sing us a song, Mr. President. You're her father!"

"Fuh-uh," said the President, with a smile and a wave.

The President was in Washington for his westward swing, he accused Dewey of playing politics with the war issue.

It was prompted by Dewey's Friday statement in which the GOP candidate related "unsubstantiated support" of the original United Nations plan for partitioning the holy land. Dewey's stand was local political.

# Roosevelt Veto Kills Security To End Berlin Blockade

PARIS, Oct. 25 (UP)—Andre Vishinsky of Russia vetoed the United Nations security council's compromise proposal for settling the Berlin crisis today.

When the debate on the Berlin crisis came to a dramatic climax, for the 27th time the Russians used their veto power to kill a council resolution and council action. The vote on the proposal was 9 to 2, with Vishinsky and Dmitri Manuilsky of the Ukraine raising their hands against it. The formula, devised by the neutral members of the council, called for lifting the Berlin blockade at once and resumption of four-power negotiations.

### Battle-Geared Troops Seize French Mines

PARIS, Oct. 23 (AP)—Thirty-thousand troops and security guards in full battle kit swept through 300 square miles of northern France today as soldiers seized the richest coal mines from communist-led strikers.

The government moved swiftly toward a showdown with the 350,000 communist miners and sympathy strikers in northern France, close to economic paralysis.

Interior Minister Jules Moch announced by radio early this afternoon that the government had carried out the sweep over an area 30 miles by 10, extending from the Douai-Paris road to the Belgian border.

All Objectives Reached Moch announced that all objectives had been reached. For the first great show of force against the strikers, Moch said the government mobilized far stronger forces than it ever used in the Douai strikes which led to the 1940-41 coal strike.

### Copper Mine In Utah Tied Up by Strike

**BINGHAM, Utah, Oct. 25 (AP)—**A total of 4,500 men in this today as a result of a walkout yesterday afternoon of 311 men at the Kennecott copper open-pit mine here.

Work stopped as members of the Brotherhood of Locomotive Firemen and Enginemen completed their day shift at 2 p. m. The engineers put the electric locomotives in pits and lined up the ore cars.

Picket lines formed on all approaches to Kennecott properties in Bingham.

**None Show up**

None of the workmen employed on the evening shift showed up for work.

It was expected the strike will eventually force a shutdown of American Smelting and Refining company smelter in Gardfield. The company concentrates the copper ore taken from the crushing mills.

The union reportedly wants a \$4.08 average daily wage adjustment to bring the salary of the men who work inside the mine up to the salary of the men who haul the ore to the smelter and Gardfield crushing plants.

**Demand 'Excessive'**

A Kennecott statement said the brotherhood's demand is for \$1.75 a day more than the daily increase accepted recently by fellow workers.

The walkout was called Friday when a week of mediation attempts collapsed.

Kennecott officials earlier offered the brotherhood the same 50 cent hourly increase they had granted other mine employees in similar categories this year.

### Navy Plans Fleet Of 28 High-Speed Aircraft Carriers

**WASHINGTON, Oct. 25 (AP)—**The navy is planning a fleet of 28 high-speed aircraft carriers capable of launching the heavier and faster long-range attack planes now being developed.

While the program is long-range in nature, according to a navy announcement last night, it could be brought to completion rapidly in event of an emergency.

**Wise-Adam**, Earle W. Mills, chief of the bureau of ships, said the force will be built around the newly planned 6,000-ton super-carrier, a flush-deck, 1,000-foot-long floating airfield able to handle atom bomb carrying aircraft.

It also will include three 45,000-ton carriers of the Midway class, whose flight decks will be reinforced so they too can launch bigger planes.

The other 23 vessels that "ultimately" will join the fleet, Mills said, are of the 37,000-ton Essex class now in service. These too will be strengthened.

### New Residents Here Fled From Hitler's Austria 9 Years Ago

From Vienna to Twin Falls via Sweden and New York City was the route traveled by Mr. and Mrs. Rudolph Freund in a period of nine years. They arrived in Twin Falls three months ago after spending two and one-half years in New York.

The Freund's, natives of Austria, lived there for seven months after Hitler entered the country.

"When German occupation first began in Vienna the people were unsuspecting," Freund said. "We had no thought of war because our family in Austria was without unemployed people."

In the beginning, no one paid much attention to the Hitler regime, but after the first few months the occupation became more rigid, and soon the people were terrorized, Freund added.

Vienna was no longer the city of gaily and Strauss waltzes, but even so, it was hard for the Freund's to leave their home, where he worked in a bank.

From Austria, the Freund's went to Sweden where he was manager of a machine factory. They remained there for eight years, but received letters from friends who had come to the United States from Sweden giving detailed descriptions of the "land of opportunity" so in April, 1936, Mr. and Mrs. Freund came to America.

In New York, Freund was employed in export work and Mrs. Freund worked for the American News Agency. He both writes and speaks fluent English, German, French and Swedish.

Because of Mrs. Freund's health, she found it necessary to change climate. A friend in Twin Falls wrote them about opportunities for employment here so they left New York during the summer. Living in an apartment in the big city during the summer was "unbearably hot," Mrs. Freund said.

According to Freund, the train trip to Twin Falls was no joy ride. "In one town we had to wait five hours for our train, but we could

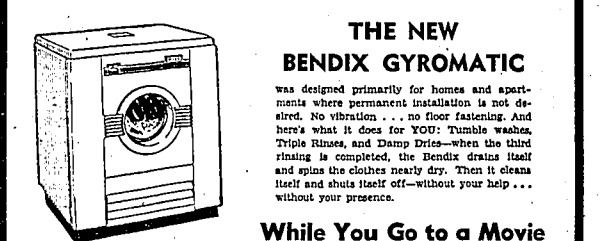

## 2 "Deserters" Of Red Army Open Curtain

Two weeks ago a Russian airplane crash-landed at an American airfield in Lima, Austria, and three men stepped out of it. Two were Russian officers; the third was a flight-sergeant.

The officers said they were deserters.

Even when confronted with the Russian commander in Austria, they persisted in saying they were through with the Soviet union, and wanted to go to the United States. That, I submit, required a very high degree of moral courage — plus a powerful inner compulsion.

Face "High Brass"

Put yourself in their place. Imagine yourself, still in uniform, facing up to the "big brass," and stating that you had deserted and were planning your flight under the protection of a nation which is, in fact, ranged against you own.

They made good their desertion, the two Russians answered questions at a news conference. Their interesting, but not entirely startling, wit:

1. They estimated that 70 per cent of the Russian population is opposed to the Communist party, but are afraid to do anything about it.
2. The communists have failed to provide the "better life" for the people that led on which the bolshevik revolution originally was sold, and in the name of which millions of Russians have died, liquidated by their own rulers, or killed during the war.
3. Opposition of the farmers to the communist program of collectivizing the farms—a struggle that brought death to an estimated 2,000,000 Russians during the 30s—still continues and is one of the great causes of unrest in the Soviet Union.

"Gues by Officers"

None of this is very new, with the possible exception of the first point, and this, necessarily, a guess on the part of the two officers. Nobody can know the feelings of 70 per cent of the Russian masses.

They also said that life in the Russian army is "not bad," but that it is maintained "at the expense of the common people."

There is a point that has interested both the military men and the economic experts in Washington for a long time. Information indicates that the Soviet union has 3,000,000 men under arms at this moment. What's the cost?

Highest Living Standard

The United States is the richest country in the world, with the highest standard of living, meaning that the individual American earns more and can buy more with what he earns.

Yet, this country is feeling the burden of the cost of re-arming, and of maintaining its armed forces.

Granted that the Soviet union may not have the expense of re-arming, because it has never demobilized or disbanded very far. Nevertheless to keep such an enormous number of men in uniform, feeding, clothing and housing them, must be a crushing burden for the Russian workers.

Doubtless, the Soviet press and radio justify this by playing on the fears of the people — fear of American "aggression," fear of the atom bomb, fear of another invasion and another campaign of brightness as in 1941.

But as time goes on, as the months pass and there is no attack, it will be increasingly difficult for the Soviet government to explain the tremendous expense as a necessary "defense measure."

Morgan said after a thorough investigation by Nez Perce officers it was discovered the crime had been in Lewis county jurisdiction. O. P. Fennell, Nez Perce Lewis county prosecutor, is expected to question Chalwin today.
