### Series of Strange Circumstances Put U. S. Citizen in Japan Army Uniform

Because the 1940 Olympic games in Japan were canceled, the present tour of the United States by Hideo Kawako as a Japanese journalist is his first visit to his birthplace in the 12 years since he sailed for Japan from Seattle. But Monday he was finally in Twin Falls to visit his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Ybourn Kawako.

Kawako came to this country Dec. 27 as one of 12 Japanese newspapermen studying the functions of a free and democratic press. The tour is part of the personal exchange program of the American occupation forces in Japan. The newspaper tour is sponsored by the American Press Institute, Columbia University, N. Y., and is financed partly by the Rockefeller foundation.

The 34-year-old writer's story of how he became a member of the Tokyo bureau, foreign news section of the Osaka Press, is a story of strange circumstances. He was born in Seattle and lived there with his parents until he was 12 years old. In 1927 his mother, wanting him to become an expert in linguistics, arranged for him to study in Japan.

It was arranged that he would study Japanese in Japan for three years. Then, in 1940, the family would go to Tokyo for the 1940 Olympics and a visit to the old country. They planned to bring him back to this country.

At this point, fate began to change Kawako's life. The 1940 Olympics were canceled because of the war in Europe. He was in his third year of high school and it was decided he might as well finish high school in Japan and then return home. The Pacific was started before he finished high school and Hideo Kawako was in Japan for the duration.

Like most other nations engaged in the war, the Japanese kept some students studying university courses in technical fields. Kawako entered the Matsuyama Commercial college and studied there until early in 1945. Upon graduation at the age of 19 he was drafted into the Japanese army and spent nine months under the "Espionage education" of the training camp before the war ended.

He was discharged immediately after the Japanese surrender.

In speculating on his activities after he returns to Japan, Kawako says he understands the journalists will submit reports of their tour to the American Press Institute and a section of the supreme commander of the Allied occupation forces, the American Press Institute and the American Editors and Publishers association.

He also expects to be sent on a lecture tour by the Japanese Editors and Publishers association. His topics for all reports and lectures will be on the elements of leadership in newspapers. He says he chose this field to study while on his American tour because of the complexity of Japanese character writing and any simplification impossible. Also, other fields such as advertising or mechanics in journalism are limited by newspaper restrictions to the point where he feels they are not important now in Japanese journalism. The Osaka Press is limited to two pages daily with a four-page paper once each week.

Kawako thinks life in the United States is fine, but admits he probably feels at home because he hasn't forgotten the 12 years he spent as a boy in Seattle.

His attitudes about the "liberal" American newspapers have shown in the tour of the journalists and says he has had to be careful in answering leading questions American reporters ask, particularly about the "Mitsubishi government."

"We're here to study American journalism, not to write stories back on our papers or discuss world affairs," he explains.

He lost his American citizenship through his long stay and army service in Japan. He hopes some day to be able to afford the court action is necessary if he is to restore his American citizenship.
