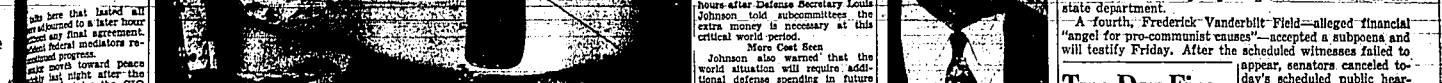

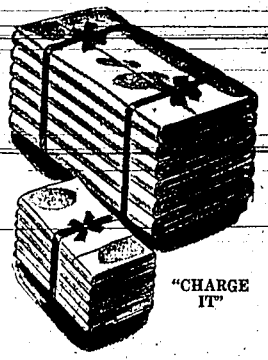

Public Report Of U. S. Reds Reveals Drop

WASHINGTON, April 26 (AP)—American citizens who publicly admitted today their membership is declining and their party organization is "seriously" blighted.

Registered party members probably do not exceed 4,000 this year.

The decline in membership is the result of last month's New York meeting of the national committee of the Communist party, U.S.A. That is the party's official style.

Communists themselves estimate they are off in membership this year by about 15 per cent from their 1949 strength. This decline has been a continuing process since 1945.

Climate Was Good

Except for a couple of years early in the war, the climate prior to 1945 was reasonably satisfactory for the growth of the Communist party and the placing of some members or sympathizers in government jobs.

But in that year began a series of incidents and disappointments which by now has aroused a great many of the members of a Communist fifth column in the United States.

The Alger Hiss case, the New York trial of Communist party leaders on charges of conspiring against the United States and revelations that FBI has its own agents operating within Communist ranks were recent jolts to the party organization.

Fallen in Depression

Communism got hit here on the depression of the 1930s. Israel Alter polled 105,681 votes in 1938 running as an avowed communist for representative-at-large in New York state. It is estimated that by the end of World War II there were upward of 75,000 enrolled communists in this country, perhaps as many as 100,000. That does not include the fellow travelers and stooges who flocked to the communists.

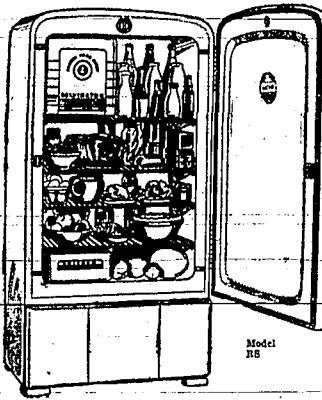

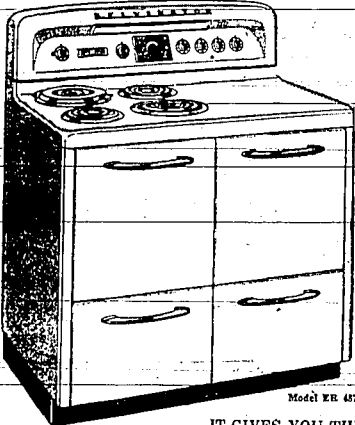

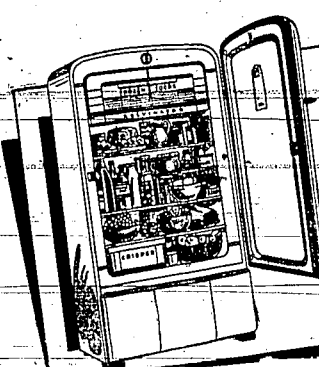

Leading Cause of Deaths for Valley Is Heart Disease

Heart disease was the major cause of death in Magic Valley during February, according to the Idaho Department of public health division of vital statistics. Three deaths occurred from other accidents in Jerome county and three from other accidents in Twin Falls county.

Training-Deadline Effects Reported

The effects of the July 21, 1964, deadline for starting GI bill of rights training courses on veterans who are already enrolled in courses were explained Wednesday by Arnold Heivess, Magic Valley veterans administration contact representative. A representative of the program explained that the deadline is the VA representative explained. However, once a veteran completes or discontinues his course after the deadline he may not start another course. 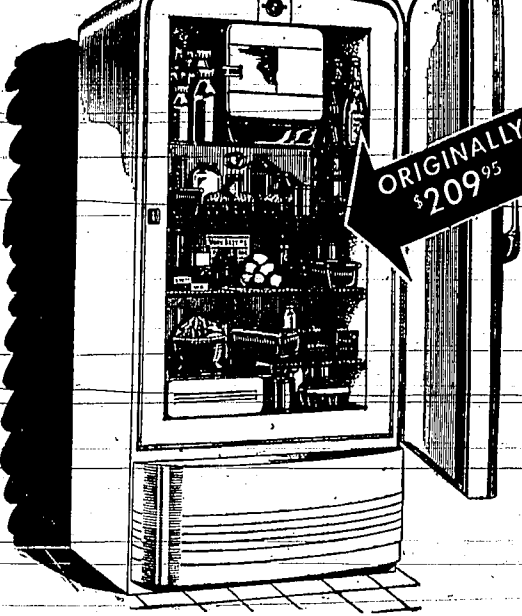

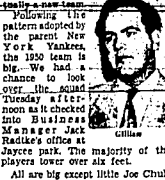

Another Year For Confused Time Nearing

NEW YORK, April 25 (AP)—Some 80,000,000 Americans will turn their timepieces ahead one hour April 30, ushering in another season of daylight saving time.

But the advent of "fast time" will be opposed by some 50,000,000 other Americans, mostly in the rural regions of the south, midwest and far west.

Clock switching will be general in the heavily industrial areas of the east and in most of the nation's large cities.

Delroit, however, will remain on standard time.

Proposed by Franklin D. Roosevelt, the "fast time" was first proposed by Benjamin Franklin nearly a century and a half ago. "Fast time" was its original title in the United States during the World War.

Some areas have used it ever since, but others have tried it and abandoned it. The mere suggestion that it be adopted in some towns and states has touched off bitter community wrangles. Legislatures have even passed laws forbidding its use.

In Nevada, gamblers widely opposed its adoption on the ground that citizens would spend extra hours outdoors when they could be starting on night life rounds.

Confusion Certain

Some confusion seems almost certain to arise out of railroad schedules. Most roads will cling to standard time but others will operate on the new time.

Those states using daylight time on a statewide basis or in some large cities are:

New York, Nevada, Delaware, Oregon, Illinois, Washington, California, Montana, New Hampshire, Maine, Missouri, Maryland, Indiana, Connecticut, Rhode Island, Massachusetts, New Jersey, Ohio, Pennsylvania, West Virginia and Kentucky.

This is in considerable degree a psychological assault which is coming from numerous directions to make it confusing. It is aimed not only at the governments but at the general public of the democracies.

The purpose is to create nervousness, weakness and anxiety among the various populations. The constant hammering with incidents and belittling statements, which savor of war, is calculated to break down morale.

This war of nerves isn't just a flash in the pan. It is a studied part of Moscow's strategy, and it accounts for many of the otherworldly inexplicable actions of the Soviet, such as the perpetual disruption of United Nations activities by the use of the everlasting "myri" (no).

This war of nerves may, or may not, be depriving us a lot of work. However, the wide man will note this very important fact:
