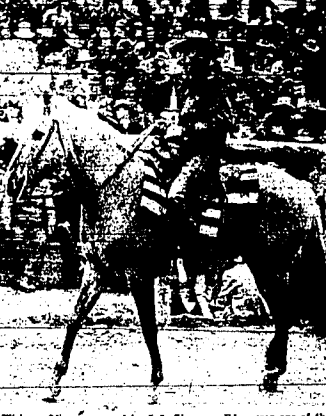

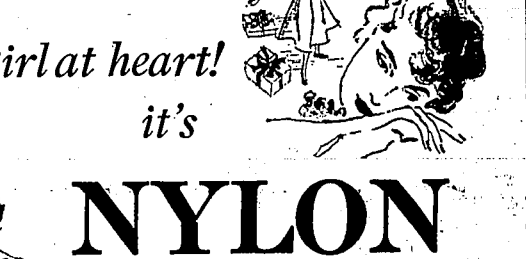

WASHINGTON, May 8 (AP)—A bill to create a single bookkeeping account for all reclamation projects on upper basin tributaries of the Columbia river has been introduced in Congress.

The measure was designed to establish safeguards for present and future developments on the Kootenai and Clear Fork rivers. It was offered by Senators Dwyer and McCar, of Montana.

The account would include all reclamation, flood control and power projects on the two "most intricate streams" that flow into the Columbia.

The legislation is designed to make revenues from sale of power generated at the proposed Libby dam on the Kootenai and other power structures which may be built, available for irrigation work.

Two western Montana projects would be among those to benefit. These existing projects are the Bitter Root valley, including the Woodside unit, and the Missoula.

The Senate has turned down an attempt to create a basin account for all the Columbia river projects. It also refused one to set up a "libby basin account" with the proposed Hell's canyon dam on Snake river, as the source of revenue for the

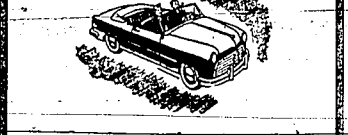
