

#### HIGH COST OF DEFENSE

If you ever get to thinking that we're put-ting out too much money for defense, it might be well to take a look at what's hap-pened to the cost of things our military men must buy.

For example, back in the good old prewar

days the average military plane bought by the government cost \$280,000. Today it comes

the government cost \$280,000. 1000; it comes to \$975,000. The figures on planes are more startling when broken down, A wartime fighter cost \$100,000, while a jet-powered craft to replace that. The original B-20's cost \$2,000,000 each twill cost at least \$150,000, maybe twice that. The original B-20's cost \$2,000,000 each Put a B-30 or a jet B-47 in its place today and the bill may hit, \$4,000,000. A dozen B-30's jiying over town on some ceremonious occasion mean \$48,000,000, not counting operating costs.
