





Idano's first newspaper was the Golden Aos, a four-page, six-column weekly which started publication on August 2, 1862, at Lewiston. It was closely followed by Idaho City's Boise. News in 1863, the Idano Daily Statesman at Boise in 1864, and Silver City's Ownizes Avalance in 1865.
