Job Level for County Stays At High Mark

Business and industrial employment in Twin Falls county during the first five months of the year has remained at the high level as during 1941, the local employment security agency reported Monday.

The average number of persons employed in business and industrial establishments in 1942 was 3,680 compared with 3,580 in 1941. However, the total payroll for these categories in 1942 was \$14,700,000, higher than \$12,500,000 paid in 1941.

The information given by the employment security agency did not include employment in governmental service, agriculture, interstate railroads, maritime activities.

In mining, the number of employes increased from 11 in 1941 to 24 in 1942. In construction the number of employed stayed about the same with 572 in 1941 and 570 in 1942.

In the transportation, communications and utility field, employment increased a very large amount from 538 persons in 1941 to 624 persons in 1942.

Finance, insurance and real estate employment also showed a very large increase from 223 employes in 1941 to 222 in 1942.

Miscellaneous employment decreased from 404 employes in 1941 to 378 employes in 1942.

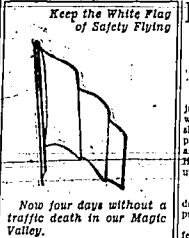

### Anti-Wind Irrigation Methods Will Be Shown Near Wendell

At an irrigation demonstration Friday in Twin Falls county, Magic Valley farmers had an opportunity to study measures for control of water erosion of irrigated land. Countermeasures against wind-blown water—erosion of irrigated land will be shown at a demonstration—Thursday in Gooding county.

Earl Jones, district conservationist, points out wind erosion to severe near Wendell and Dietrich and southwest of Jerome. In Jerome county there are 20,000 acres of sandy windblown irrigated soils, and another 15,000 acres in Gooding county, he added in urging a large attendance at the Tuesday demonstration.

The Gooding soil conservation district is sponsoring an irrigation demonstration on sandy soils, starting at 2 p. m. Tuesday on the Alvin McConnell farm four miles west of Wendell.

Wayne Criddle, Boise, soil conservation service irrigation engineer, will lead discussions on technical phases of the demonstration, and Kenneth King, Wendell area supervisor of the Gooding Soil Conservation district, will be the master of ceremonies and announce the program.

Supervisors and farmers from the neighboring Wood River and North Side Soil Conservation districts are encouraged to participate. Large areas of sandy soil which are subject to severe wind erosion are found in each of the three conservation districts.

This demonstration is the first to be held on sandy soils and will be of particular interest to farmers in similar areas. Jones pointed out the added soils vary greatly in their ability to soak up water and to store water for plant use depending upon texture, depth and composition.

The purpose of the demonstration is to show some of the principles of conservation irrigation on sandy windblown soils. Assisting in the
