

Truman to Give Report On Crisis to Congress, People This Wednesday

WASHINGTON, July 17 (AP)—President Truman will tell congress and the nation Wednesday what he believes is needed to check out of South Korea.
The president is expected to ask for \$5,000,000,000 or more in new defense funds, and to announce that he has ordered a 10 percent increase in the pay of the armed forces from more than \$200,000,000 a year to \$220,000,000 a year.
Truman is expected to announce that he has authorized contract authorizations totaling approximately \$6,000,000,000 for the fiscal year 1951.
The president is expected to announce that he has authorized an additional 100,000 men for the national guard limit of 837,000, and about 100,000 men for the national guard.
The president is expected to announce that he has authorized an increase also in the 602,000-man national guard ceiling. The three services now are nearly 600,000 men short of their authorized strength of 2,005,882.

4. Postponing any action now on proposals for increasing any of the 11 national guard divisions.
Mr. Truman, under the selective service act, already has authority to order reservists to active duty, and is expected to inform congress he has designated that authority to Defense Secretary Johnson.
Other reports indicated he also might give Johnson power to call up national guard units if the secretary deems necessary.

Tank-Shed Divisions Driving Near U.S. Field Headquarters on Taejon

WASHINGTON, July 17 (AP)—Three North Korean infantry divisions, heavily aided by artillery but shy on tanks, swarmed close on Taejon today, forcing the slender American defense to abandon the airfield three miles north of the South Korean city, Gen. Douglas MacArthur's Tokyo headquarters communique reported early this morning that the North Korean invaders are "continuing to push a high price for ground gained," but acknowledged that they were gaining.
Late field dispatches said Taejon, until last week the provisional capital of the Korean republic and site of American field headquarters, was still in American hands, but virtually deserted. Its abandonment appeared near.
A Washington defense department spokesman intimated that American troops might be based on a high ridge some 38 miles southeast, on the Kum River, but that had not been decided.
MacArthur's public information officer, Col. M. P. Nichols, echoed this and said the loss of Taejon would have no more than a morale effect and that the Americans were already withdrawing to a more rugged and more easily defensible terrain.
MacArthur described the Americans as withdrawing from the Kum River-Northern line, which is an expanse of more than 200 square miles south of the Kum River, which flows into the sea at the mouth of the Kum River, which is 20 miles south of Taejon.
The state department reported that the enemy had succeeded in getting only two tanks across to the south bank of the Kum River, but that they had been destroyed. Field dispatches indicated that the "reds" had brought up more armor. This evidently came from the heavy red artillery which MacArthur reported were building up just north of the Kum River.
Associated Press Correspondent William R. Moore, who visited Taejon last week, said that the city, most of its 100,000 population had fled to the south bank of the Kum River, and that the city was in the hands of the North Korean army.

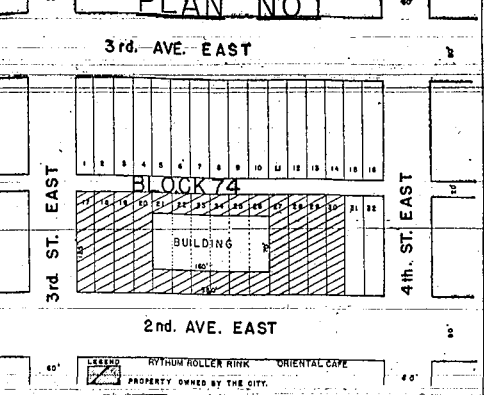

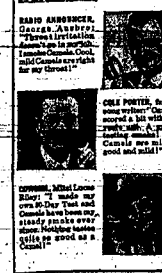
